PASTOR'S CORNER...

DEAR PARISHIONERS,

(On the Holy Eucharist #21)

The Holy Eucharist fills a soul with grace. When God interacts with a soul, this is called grace. Because God is all-powerful, a soul cannot help but be affected every time God interacts with it, making it holy. However, the transformation can be momentarily or long-lasting, depending on the soul's disposition. The momentary grace is called actual grace, while the long-lasting grace is called sanctifying grace. Every time a soul avails itself to one of the seven Sacraments, God certainly interacts with it (actual grace). But God can only continue to dwell in the soul (sanctifying grace) when it does not separate itself from God through sin. In this way, it can be said emphatically that the Holy Eucharist as a Sacrament par excellence fills a soul with grace.

Regarding May 9th, 2024 (Thu.)

The Ascension of the Lord (Solemnity), our ecclesiastical province (and most dioceses in USA) has transferred this Solemnity from Thursday, May 9th to Sunday May 12th. Thursday, May 9th is observed as an Easter weekday. **The Ascension of the Lord (Solemnity) is celebrated on May 12th, 2024** (Sun.) in the Diocese of Orange.

May 4-5: Parishes in Collaboration

Parishes in Collaboration Collection will be taken up in the Diocese of Orange this weekend, May 4-5. Holy Family will not have a second collection for this appeal, instead, a portion of our weekend offertory will be given in support. This collection is for the purpose of assisting parishes in the Diocese of Orange that exhibit ongoing needs that cannot be paid for by their ordinary income and have urgent needs (such as repairs and maintenance). All money donated to this collection is put into a restricted fund that is administered by a group consisting of laity and clergy of the diocese. Parishes with needs as stated above may apply for grants from this fund to be used for their specific needs. In years past, the committee has focused on grants regarding safety issues including emergency electrical, plumbing repairs and roofing. By participating in the **Parishes in Collaboration** appeal, all people of the Diocese of Orange are helping one another support the works of our parishes that struggle financially. Thank you for your generosity.

May 12-13: Second Collection Planned Mother's Day Roses Event

The month of May is dedicated to Mary, our spiritual mother—to honor our earthly mothers, please offer your intentions on our website or using the novena cards at the doors. We will again host the Mother's Day Roses event May 11-12, with a second collection benefitting the Life Center of Santa Ana.

Parish Sacrificial Giving—April 28, 2024

Our offertory collection during Masses was down last weekend at \$13,075 versus last year at \$14,159. Our EFT weekly average was \$9,479, versus \$8,769 last year. In total, our weekly offertory was \$22,554 versus last year at \$22,928.

Faith Question of the Week

QUESTION: Can you take the body of Christ more than once a day?

Answer: Yes. Current Canon law permits the reception of Holy Communion up to two times each calendar day. The first time can be in the context of a Mass, Communion Service, or some other rite that involves the distribution of Holy Communion by a valid minister. To receive it a second time it must be in the context of a Mass that you have actively participated in.

It's Official!

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) has had its name officially changed in the United States as of Spring, 2024. It is now known as The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) as a more accurate translation of the rites promulgated after the second Vatican Council have been delivered. While the name is changed, the purpose remains the same. This is the process that is used to bring those above the age of reason (those aged 8-88+) into full communion with the Catholic Church. Whether it is minors and adults coming from another Christian or non-Christian faith background, practicing Catholics that have not completed one or more of their sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, Communion), Catholics that have fallen away and want to return, or Catholics seeking a better understanding of our faith - OCIA is the vehicle.



Throughout May, June, and July we will be conducting inquiry sessions after specific Sunday Masses (**look for dates/times on the faith formation board outside the north Transept entrance or in the bulletin**) for those that are interested in learning more about the process or have questions about the faith that they would like answered. If you have friends, family members, neighbors, etc...that have expressed an interest in exploring the Catholic Faith and receiving their sacraments invite them to join us. 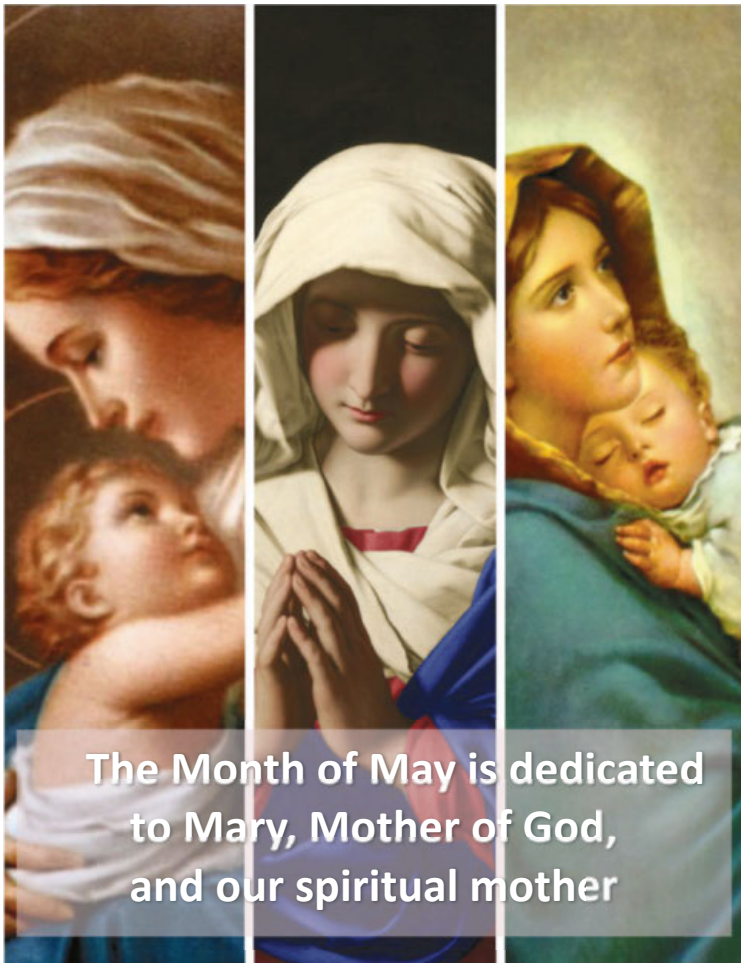

The Month of May is dedicated to Mary, Mother of God, and our spiritual mother

Why do we call Mary our mother?

At the beginning of the third session of the Second Vatican Council, Pope Paul VI announced that Mary would be honored under the title "Mother of the Church."

From Christ's conception until his death, Mary was united to her Son in his work of salvation. From the Cross, Jesus entrusted his beloved disciple to Mary, telling him to see her as his own mother (Jn 19:27). When the Apostles and disciples gathered to pray after the Ascension of Jesus, Mary was with them praying for the coming of the Holy Spirit. Mary continues to pray before God for the Church and all humanity.

Like Mary, the Church has a maternal role, giving birth to people in Christ. The Church can never cease to look at Mary, who gave birth to Jesus Christ. The Church contemplates Mary's motherhood in order to fulfill her own calling to be mother of the members of Christ's Mystical Body, the Church. Also like Mary, the Church is virginal. The

description of the Church as virginal is used here in the spiritual sense of the undivided heart and of fidelity in its most luminous form. God calls all the members of the Church to fidelity to the union with him begun at Baptism and continued in the other Sacraments.

In our culture, there can be a discomfort with praying for Mary's intercession on our behalf. This seems to be a mediating role that crosses a line set out in the First Letter to Timothy: "For there is one God. / There is also one mediator between God and the human race, / Christ Jesus, himself human / who gave him-self as a ransom for all" (1 Tm 2:5). So Jesus Christ is the one and only mediator. Jesus alone is the Savior.

But this does not deny the possibility that Christ would permit others to share in his mediating role. Here on earth we routinely ask others for prayers. Instinctively, we turn to holy people for their prayers because they seem nearer to God. Why would we stop asking saints for their prayers after they die? If we believe they are in heaven, would not their prayers be even

This month of May, we prepare to lift up special women that have touched our lives as we honor our spiritual mother, Mary, Holy Mother of God.

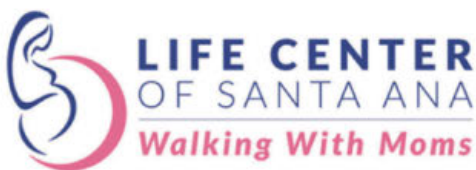
In anticipation of Mother's Day this year, we are dedicating nine days of Mass intentions to honor the women who, like Mary, have had special places in our lives.

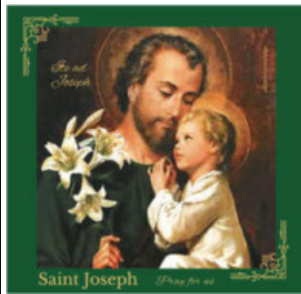

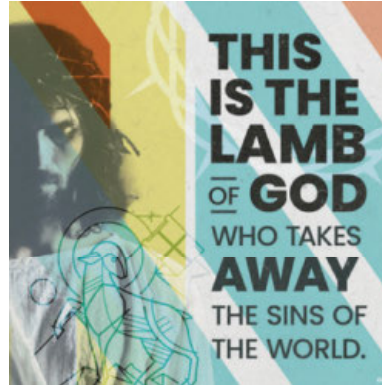

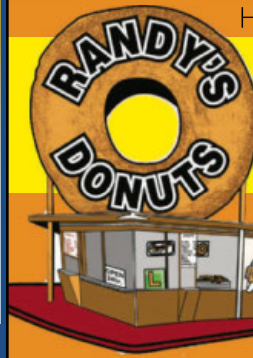
