## GOSPEL REFLECTION

### 2ND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

1 Samuel 3:10

Psalm 40

1 Corinthians 6:15, 17

John 1:39

As a priest, I'm amazed how happily married couples remember the tiniest details of their earliest encounters. They effortlessly report things like: "he wore a blue shirt," "we ordered brussels sprouts," "her hair was up in a bun," and "he spilled shrimp cocktail sauce at my family's open front door when it was ten degrees below zero," (that one's courtesy of my mom). We delight in remembering and speaking of when our new life of love began. The little details are glorious reminders that it's all real.

It's similar for John the Apostle. He tells us of the two disciples who followed Jesus into his house, "...they stayed with him that day. It was about four o'clock in the afternoon." Why does that tiny detail matter? Because that's the time of day when they encountered the love of Jesus the Messiah in their lives. Our religion is not primarily about abstract truths about God, no matter how true or sublime. It is about God meeting and saving us in our human nature. It's about a human relationship.

What was the time of day when you first recall encountering Christ and his Church? Who was there? What did you feel? How did things look and smell? What happened? Take some time to recall it in detail. For me, it was inside an old, rickety church on a hillside in Jerome, Arizona. It was about 9 p. m. on a Saturday evening. I was with my friends Jenny, Brad, and Laura. We were praying, singing, and laughing. When was it for you? Remembering the details isn't empty nostalgia. It reminds us now that God's love for us in our humanity is real.

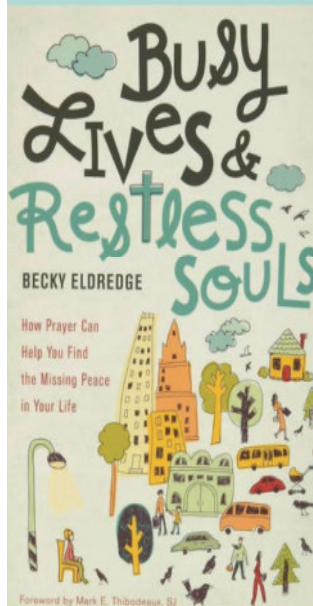

What is a **“CATECHIST”**?

*The word “catechist” is an ancient Greek word used by Christians to describe those who have faith and teach the faith. It means “to echo,” “to hand down.”*

Anyone could take a few classes on Christianity or Catholicism and probably ‘teach’ it to others. But unless it's their own faith, they aren’t “catechists.” They aren’t handing down what they’ve heard echoing within themselves.

**The word “teacher” is often used as a synonym for “catechist” — but for those of us in the field of faith formation, we are looking for “catechists” rather than “teachers.”**

**VOCATION MINISTRY**



The word “vocation” is derived from the Latin word “vocare,” which means a calling or summoning. A vocation is God’s invitation to love and serve him and his Church in a particular state or way of life, leading to holiness.

**The Vocations of the Church:**

The Priesthood

A priest is expected to be a man of prayer and contemplation. With this deeper, intimate knowledge of the person and work of Christ, the priest is sent forth to minister to Christ’s people. During a priest’s ordination, his soul is changed forever, and he now stands *in persona Christi capitis*, or “in the person of Christ, the head (of the Church).”

The Religious Life

The religious or consecrated life is a vocation, like marriage and priesthood, where men and women seek an intimate relationship with Christ. It is a grace given by God as he chooses a person, calling the individual to a special relationship with him. Religious sisters and brothers are witnesses to the world that we are all ultimately called to unite with Christ.

Marriage

The vocation of marriage is a call to a life of holiness and selflessness within the relationship between a man and a woman. Marriage between two baptized persons is a sacrament, meaning their relationship conveys in a distinctive way the bond of love between Christ and his people.

 Amen*

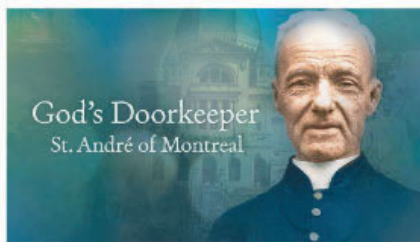
