### Feast of the Transfiguration


#### A View from the Mountaintop

## (PRACTICING) CATHOLIC - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

### Transfigured

We have all had moments when we seem to get a glimpse of Heaven.

For me, they come with the sacraments: in the pew following my First Communion, kneeling before the bishop as he sealed my forehead with oil at my Confirmation, standing opposite my husband on our wedding day, cradling my newborns as the priest poured holy water over their little foreheads, claiming them for Christ.

Moments when the veil between this world and the one to come is pulled away, and our hearts cry out: “Lord, it is good we are here.”

Like Peter at the Transfiguration, we desperately wish the feeling would last forever. We want to hang onto the certainty, the confidence and the joy that radiates from our souls. We want to spend forever looking upon the transfigured face of Christ.

But we are not in heaven yet. We raise our eyes, seeing only this world before us, the words of Jesus ringing in our ears: “Rise, and do not be afraid.”

## The Transfiguration of the Lord

What is Christianity finally about? These days if you ask almost anyone who doesn't know the Bible you'll probably hear an answer like this: “Being a good person” or “following the golden rule.” No offense to the golden rule, but our faith is simply much stranger than that. This week's feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord is a luminous example of this. Jesus becomes radiantly and overwhelmingly beautiful. The glory of God literally shines forth from his body and even his clothes. Here we see that Christianity is not mainly a moral system, but a relationship with God in Christ, one that finally makes human beings gloriously beautiful.

Now we can see our good and bad deeds in a new and de-centered way. Our morality isn't about a heaven or hell scorecard. It's about lives open (or closed) to transfiguration, lives capable of revealing the glory of God in Christ to the world. Spouses, children, friends, co-workers, priests,

consecrated women and men, and so on — we are all called to let the beauty of Jesus make our lives beautiful, little by little. His beauty in us is the center of our faith.



**Servant of God Nicholas Black Elk**



Servant of God Nicholas Black Elk was a Lakota convert to Catholicism at the turn of the 19th century. He led hundreds to Christ while also helping his community preserve their Lakota traditions. He's remembered fondly as a catechist, healer, and cultural leader.

**Born:** December 1, 1863 Powder River, MT

**Died:** August 19, 1950, Pine Ridge Reservation, SD

**Place of burial:** St. Agnes Catholic Cemetery, Manderson-White Horse Creek, SD





## (PRACTICANDO) CATÓLICA: RECONOCE A DIOS EN TUS MOMENTOS ORDINARIOS

### Transfigurado

Todos hemos tenido momentos en los que parece que vislumbramos el Cielo.

Para mí, vienen con los sacramentos: en el banco después de mi Primera Comunión, de rodillas ante el obispo mientras me sellaba la frente con aceite en mi Confirmación, de pie frente a mi esposo el día de nuestra boda, acunando a mis recién nacidos mientras el sacerdote derramaba agua bendita sobre sus pequeñas frentes, reclamándolos para Cristo.

Momentos en que se corre el velo entre este mundo y el venidero, y nuestro corazón clama: “Señor, es bueno que estemos aquí.”

Al igual que Pedro en la Transfiguración, deseamos desesperadamente que el sentimiento dure para siempre. Queremos aferrarnos a la certeza, la confianza y la alegría que irradia de nuestra alma. Queremos pasar una eternidad contemplando el rostro transfigurado de Cristo Pero todavía no estamos en el cielo. Levantamos nuestros ojos, viendo solo este mundo delante de nosotros, las palabras de Jesús resonando en nuestros oídos: "Levántate, y no tengas miedo."

### VIVIR LA LITURGIA - INSPIRACIÓN DE LA SEMANA

“No cuenten la visión a nadie hasta que el Hijo de Hombre haya resucitado de entre los muertos,” dijo Jesús a sus discípulos. ¿Por qué mantener en secreto algo tan asombroso como la Transfiguración? Porque el mundo no estaba listo aún para el final de la historia. A veces, la gloria solo tiene sentido después de las pruebas.

### 17° Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Nuestra vocación cristiana tiene su raíz en la revelación del amor de Dios por medio de Jesús. Este domingo, pidámosle a Dios, que nos dé el regalo de seguir escuchando su voz y profundizar en su Palabra: “¡Este es mi Hijo, el Amado; éste es mi Elegido, ¡escúchenlo!” (Mateo 17:5). Señor, tres discípulos tuyos fueron los elegidos para acompañarte al monte y ser testigos de verte transfigurado. Hoy, también a nosotros nos ofreces momentos íntimos para estar contigo, para admirar todo lo que haces por nosotros en el vivir de cada día. Nuestro compromiso de cristianos es estar bien atentos a tu diaria presencia en nuestra vida.

Jesús, antes de su Pasión, nos muestra su Transfiguración para que estemos listos a entender el misterio de su sufrimiento. El misterio de amor, dar su vida por nosotros. Gloria y sufrimiento se unen mostrando el infinito amor de Dios. Ante el sufrimiento, no debemos tener miedo, sino fijarnos cómo Jesús es valiente en aceptar la voluntad de su Padre. La experiencia de los discípulos fue de gozo y de miedo, sin embargo, Jesús anima diciendo: “Levántense, no tengan miedo. Ellos levantaron los ojos, pero ya no vieron a nadie más que a Jesús” (Mateo 16:7-8). Él nos levantará de todos nuestros sufrimientos y miedos. La esperanza debe estar puesta en su resurrección. Los momentos de fe y gracia que el Señor nos da, nos alentarán.
