

Societa del Santo Rosario

History of Societa del Santo Rosario

In 1922, under the strong-willed leadership of a small group of faithful Italian Immigrant women, The Societa del Santo Rosario, the oldest organization at Our Lady of the Rosary parish, was founded. On October 3, 1923, the officers were elected to establish the foundation and ideals of the society which is to be true "Roses of Mary." Led by the Pastor, Rev. Silvestri Rabagliati, the first

celebrations of the society were in the original building that was the church and meeting place of the parish. That building now houses Our Lady's Gifts.

Members strive to live and work every day as intercessors by praying for the salvation of souls. Through fraternal and friendly spirit among the women, the society promotes a commitment to the Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, with the goal to foster the devotion in others. Each member of the society understands and is committed to the power of the rosary and dedicates themselves to pray the rosary daily.

Every year in the months of May and October the society prays the rosary before every mass with the congregation of Our Lady of the Rosary parish.

Feast Day Celebration

The Societa del Santo Rosario celebrates the feast day on the first Sunday in October. For more than sixty years, the sodality has conducted a ceremonial presentation of a rosary to be placed on the statue of Our Lady by the Rosary Girls. The celebration begins with a procession of the four Rosary Girls: the presenter, the pillow carrier, and two attendants. The rosary is carried on a pillow to the altar to be blessed by the priest. The girls process to the hymn, "O Del Rosario." Following the presentation of the rosary, the society president leads the congregation in the recitation of the rosary.





















CANTICLE OF THE CREATURES

Do you have brothers and sisters? Did you ever think of the sun and moon as your brother or sister?

On October 4 we celebrate the feast of St. Francis. Francis loved all of creation and was grateful for all the wonderful things God created for us. He taught everyone to appreciate and be thankful for all of God's gifts. He wrote a song of gratitude and praise called "Canticle of the Creatures," naming many parts of creation and describing how they praise God just by being what they were created to be.




He sang of "Brother Sun" and "Sisters Moon and Stars." He called wind and air his brothers and water his sister. "Brother Fire" was praised for his light and power. "Sister Earth" was thanked for feeding us with her bounty and giving us the beauty of flowers. He even honored "Sister Death." Francis's canticle reminds us that all creation

gives praise to God. So should we!

Think of some other parts of God's wonderful creation not named by Francis. Make a list and describe them as "Brother" or "Sister," for example, "Brother Fox" and "Sister Cloud." Draw a picture for each example. Try to come up with one picture each day. Collect them into a booklet and use them as part of your prayer before you go to sleep each night.



This could become a very large book! You could add a picture every day of the year and never run out of reasons to praise and thank God.


