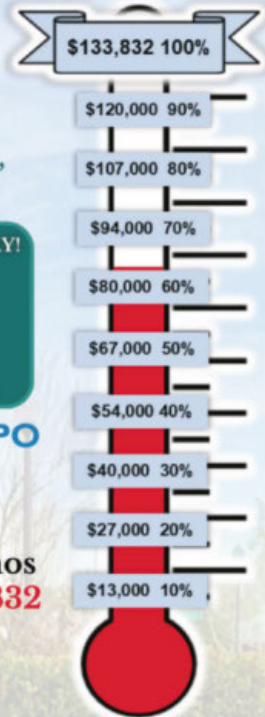

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Peace Be With You

If the world needs something now, it is peace. Society must turn its heart towards God to find it. We must leave selfishness aside and see that attacking each other does not achieve anything. The disciples of Emmaus, after finding Jesus, felt peace in their hearts and prepared to tell the happy news to others. Didn't we feel our hearts burn when he spoke to us on the road and explained the Scriptures to us? (Luke 24:32). And in another passage of the Gospel, Jesus appears among them and says to them: "Peace be with you." Lord, help us find that peace that you give us, may our bad feelings be calmed by your promised peace. "This change of step, from self to God, from yes to yes, how did it occur in the disciples? Meeting Jesus: the two from Emmaus first open their hearts to him; then they will hear him explain the Scriptures; Then they invite him to his house. There are three steps that we can also take in our homes: first, open our hearts to Jesus, entrusting him with the burdens, the difficulties, the disappointments of life, entrusting him with our yeses; and then second step, listen to Jesus, take the Gospel in hand, reading this passage today, in chapter twenty-four of the Gospel of Luke; third, pray to Jesus, with the same words as those disciples: Lord, stay with us (Luke 24:29). Lord, stay with me? Lord, stay with all of us, because we need you to find the way. And without you it is night." Pope Francisco 04-23-2020. ©LPi

Los discípulos de Emaús, luego de encontrar a Jesús, fue que sintieron la paz en sus corazones y se dispusieron a contar la feliz noticia a los demás. ¿No sentíamos arder nuestro corazón cuando nos hablaba en el camino y nos explicaba las Escrituras? (Lucas 24:32). Y en otro pasaje del Evangelio, Jesús, se presenta en medio de ellos y les dice: "Paz a ustedes". Señor, ayúdanos a encontrar esa paz que nos brindas, que nuestros malos sentimientos sean tranquilizados por tu paz prometida. "Este cambio de paso, del yo a Dios, del sí al sí, ¿cómo ocurrió en los discípulos? Encontrándose con Jesús: los dos de Emaús primero le abren su corazón; luego le escuchan explicar las Escrituras; luego le invitan a su casa. Son tres pasos que también nosotros podemos dar en nuestras casas: primero, abrir el corazón a Jesús, confiándole las cargas, las dificultades, las desilusiones de la vida, confiándole los sí; y luego segundo paso, escuchar a Jesús, tomar el Evangelio en la mano, leyendo hoy mismo este pasaje, en el capítulo veinticuatro del Evangelio de Lucas; tercero rezar a Jesús, con las mismas palabras de aquellos discípulos: Señor, quédate con nosotros (Lucas 24:29). Señor, quédate conmigo. Señor, quédate con todos nosotros, porque te necesitamos para encontrar el camino. Y sin ti es de noche". Papa Francisco 04-23-2020. ©LPi

National Child Abuse Prevention Month (April)

April is designated as National Child Abuse Prevention Month. Throughout the year, but especially in the month of April, all are asked to increase awareness, to educate ourselves and our community, and to seek healing for those who have been impacted by abuse.

**DID YOU
KNOW?**

Did you know . . . Child abuse comes in many forms. Most people identify child abuse as physically hitting a child. Neglect is also a form of abuse. Failing to provide a child with proper nutrition or supervision can cause harm. The Diocese of Stockton provides training for all adults and youth to identify the warning signs and develop strategies for maintaining a safe environment for all. A designated Victim Assistance Coordinator is available to receive reports and accompany victims through their journey. The Victim Assistance Coordinator for the Diocese of Stockton is **Brande Vargas**. A volunteer independent review board assists the Bishop in the review of cases and makes recommendations for moving forward. A Safe Environment Manager assists parish and school personnel with training and background screenings for anyone who may have access to children and vulnerable adults. The Safe Environment Manager for our Diocese is **Isela Quezada**.

Each church, school or preschool in the Diocese of Stockton has a Safe Environment Coordinator who oversees the training and screenings at the parish level. Online trainings must be updated every three years. An audit is conducted annually by an independent firm to evaluate the implementation of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. Findings are made available in an annual report. It is the responsibility for all persons to protect children and the vulnerable among us, "whoever receives one child such as this in my name receives me." Matthew 18:5

Mes Nacional de Prevención del Abuso de Niños (Abril)

Abril está designado como el Mes Nacional de Prevención del Abuso de Niños. A lo largo del año, pero especialmente en los meses de Abril, se pide a todos que nos eduquemos, y que busquemos curación para aquellos que han sido afectados por el abuso.

Sabías Que?

Sabías . . . El abuso de niños se presenta de muchas formas. La mayoría de la gente identifica el abuso de niños como golpear físicamente a un niño. La negligencia y no darle nutrición o supervisión también es una forma de abuso. La Diócesis de Stockton entrena a todos los adultos y jóvenes para identificar las señales de advertencia y desarrollar estrategias para mantener un lugar seguro para todos. Un Coordinador de Asistencia a Víctimas designado está disponible para recibir informes y acompañar a las víctimas en su viaje. La Coordinadora de

Asistencia a Víctimas de la Diócesis de Stockton es Brande Vargas. Una junta de revisión independiente ayuda al Obispo en los casos y hace recomendaciones para seguir adelante. Un Gerente de Ambiente Seguro ayuda a la parroquia y la escuela con entrenamiento y evaluación de cualquier persona que pueda tener acceso a niños y adultos vulnerables. La Gerente de Ambiente Seguro de nuestra Diócesis es Isela Quezada.

Cada iglesia, escuela o preescolar en la Diócesis de Stockton tiene un Coordinador de Ambiente Seguro quien supervisa el entrenamiento y las evaluaciones a nivel parroquial. El entrenamiento en línea deben hacerse cada tres años. Anualmente una empresa independiente realiza una auditoría para evaluar la implementación de la Carta para la Protección de Niños y Jóvenes. Los resultados están disponibles en un informe anual. Es responsabilidad de todas las personas proteger a los niños y a los vulnerables entre nosotros, "Quien reciba en mi nombre un niño como este, a mí me recibe". Mateo 18:5

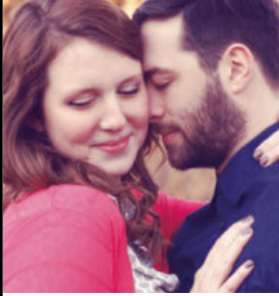

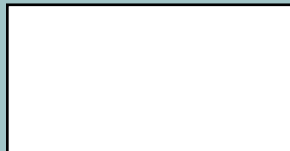

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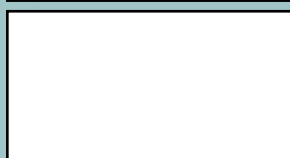
