## Message from the Pastor



### FATHER'S DAY

I was very blessed to have a father who loved and supported me during my life's journey. He was the one who taught me how to throw a baseball and football. He was the one who taught me how to play golf and I have many fond memories of our time together on the golf course. He was the one who taught me how to drive and thankfully he was able to live and tell about it. Of all the lessons he taught me the three that had the most impact on my life were: the importance of the Catholic faith, the importance of family and his example of his love for my mother. Although it has been twenty years since he has died, his influence in my life continues and for that I am very thankful.

Unfortunately, in the United States today almost one in four children grow up without a father in the home. For African Americans, it is some 65 percent of children. Some people think those statistics are insignificant. They're wrong. The vast majority of the incarcerated juveniles have grown up in fatherless homes. Teen and other mass murderers almost invariably have filial rupture in their biographies. Absent fathers predict higher rates of truancy, psychiatric problems, criminality, promiscuity, drug use, rape, domestic violence and other less-than-optimal outcomes.

Here is another pertinent, albeit socially radioactive fact: Fatherlessness leads to a search for father substitutes, and some of these father placeholders turn out to be toxic. The murder rates in inner cities, for example, are irreducibly familial phenomena. That's because the murder problem is largely a gang problem. (Minnesota Psychological Association Study, August 2020)

Single parents do heroic work and I wonder if we as a community of faith could do more in support. I am open to suggestions. I am convinced that having a vibrant youth program is helpful, but maybe there is more we could do to help. Through the intercession of St. Joseph and with the power of God's grace, we can make a difference and change those statistics.

On this Father's Day let us give thanks and praise to our fathers realizing that not everyone had a father who was loving and supportive. In this Year of St. Joseph, let us ask his intercession for all fathers that they may follow St. Joseph's example of faith and love.
