

THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

In today's Gospel, St. Luke is beginning to shift our attention away from the charismatic John the Baptist to Jesus. The Gospel omits verses (19-20) that tell of Herod imprisoning St. John. In those two verses, St. Luke is anticipating what will happen to the Baptist. The focus is now on Jesus. For St. Luke, the period of Israel comes to an end with John the Baptist (16:6). It's as if a curtain is drawn on John then opens on Jesus. Now a new age is beginning.

In St. Luke's account, he passes over the baptism quickly to move on to the Holy Spirit, who is featured in this gospel and its sequence, the Acts of the Apostles. Jesus' childhood has ended and St. Luke introduces us to the adult Jesus who is commencing His public ministry with the descent of the Holy Spirit and the proclamation to us that He is God's "beloved Son." From now on, all Jesus does and says is as God's beloved under the influence of the Spirit. Jesus is wellequipped for His life of mission and ministry.

DID YOU KNOW..."The City of Boston now allows its employees to take up to 12 weeks of leave with pay when they abort their unborn babies. The New Boston Post reports the city council passed the amendment to its parental leave policies on September 15. The vote was unanimous, and acting Mayor Kim Janey signed it two days later." "The new parental leave benefits for city employees allows up to 12 weeks of paid leave for men and women for pregnancy loss, including all abortions for any reason, according to The Post. In October the City of Portland, Oregon also approved expanding bereavement leave to include abortions. These actions are significant because they recognize, if only inadvertently, that an abortion is a loss. Unlike a miscarriage or still birth, however the loss is intentional." (LifeNews.com)
