# From Father Seibt



**Greetings** in the Lord! A special **welcome** to those who may be visiting us today.

During this **Jubilee Year of 2025** we are on a journey of renewal. What are we setting out to renew? Our hope in Christ. For we are "Pilgrims of Hope."

Just when we thought we could finally settle fully back into Ordinary Time, Jesus sends us out as **laborers for his harvest** in today's Gospel (Lk 10:1-12, 17-20) on this Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time! On Pentecost we reflected that none of us are called to do nothing for the sake of the Kingdom. Rather, all of us are called to do something. Notice what it means to be a laborer of the harvest: (1) we don't go at it alone, but rather with another - "in pairs," (2) we are going into battle - "like lambs among wolves," (3) we have to rely fully on God - "carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals...eat and drink what is offered to you," (4) we have to stay focused - "greet no one along the way," (5) we are to extend the Lord's "peace," that is, his love and salvation, (6) we are to proclaim God's kingdom, not our own - "yet know this...", and (7) when we are rejected we have to keep moving forward - "shake the dust from your feet." So, let's get to work!

Given the mission we have, it is still important to **take time and rest**. Be sure to enjoy these wonderful days of summer!

This coming weekend a large group from our *Two Parishes, One Family* is going to Steubenville, Ohio for an exciting **youth conference**. Please keep Fr. Buttner, Jen Brown, the other chaperones, and the youth in your prayers. May they come back on fire for the faith!

Next Sunday, July 13th, there will be a special blessing of the new **shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes and Saint Bernadette** at DM. It is the anniversary of the third apparition of Our Lady of Lourdes to Saint Bernadette in which she revealed tribulation for the Church in 1917. After the Mission of Saint Bernadette in Constantia closed on July 15, 2023, construction on the new shrine began. It was completed last November. Please join us for this special occasion.

Next week is **Totus Tuus** - a summer youth program for those in grades 1-12. It is always an amazing experience. Be sure to register your children, grandchildren, nieces, nephews, friends, and neighbors today! All are welcome. Note that our daily Mass schedule changes to accommodate this program. All are welcome to come to Mass and pray with us.

**OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation) sessions have begun!** If you or someone you know is looking for answers to questions about faith or to take the next step on the journey of faith, come! No commitment is required. Our parishes are always happy to walk with you!

Believe it or not, we are getting ready for our annual **Fall Festival** (formerly Apple Festival) at Sacred Heart. We decided to move it a little later in the season and to rebrand it as a "Fall Festival" so that it will not conflict with many popular Apple Festivals in our area. Many people are working behind the scenes to make it a wonderful time for all. Please help as you are able, particularly by participating in the \$15,000 giveaway and spreading the word. There are a lot of new and exciting things this year!

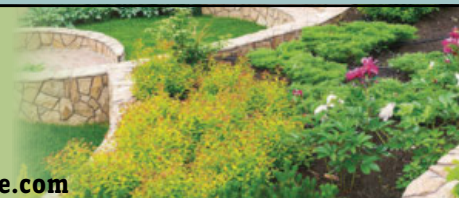

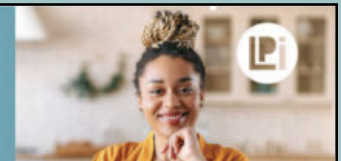
