Praised be Jesus Christ!

Thank you all so much for the welcome that I have received during these first two weeks of transition. I'm trying hard to learn names and faces but please don't be offended if I have to ask your name over and over again throughout the rest of the summer!

I'm also trying to get to know the various committees, groups, and ministries that contribute to parish life here at the Cathedral—a process that will also likely continue throughout most of July and August.

One of my first priorities, now that almost all of the restrictions are lifted, will be to reach out to our homebound parishioners who might be in need of sacramental care. Even under normal circumstances, homebound parishioners often feel disconnected from the parish when a new pastor/rector arrives since they don't have the same opportunity to "meet the new priest" at Sunday Mass as others do. But given the COVID restrictions, in many cases the sick and homebound have been without the opportunity for confession, Holy Communion, and a visit from a priest for over a year and a half. I certainly want this important segment of our parish to know that they are not forgotten.

I was recently in conversation with a priest friend of mine who pointed out that in many parishes today people assume that the priest is too busy to make such "housecall" type of visits. But that couldn't be further from the truth! If I am too busy to give proper sacramental care to the sick and elderly then I need to seriously re-examine my priorities and re-arrange my schedule.

The fact is—my regular ministry to the homebound is an important part of what helps me to be a better and more compassionate priest. I'm sure our parish Deacons would feel the same. So, I ask for your help in two important matters:

1. If you or someone you know from this parish is homebound and would like a regular visit from a priest for confession and Holy Communion, please call or email the office and let me know so that I can arrange for that.
2. *If you have been in the habit of bringing a pyx to Mass* (i.e. the special metal container used to carry the Sacred Host to the sick) *to take Holy Communion yourself to a loved one, please hold off on doing so and instead see me after Mass so that I can make proper arrangements with you one-on-one.* This will also allow me to ensure that the Blessed Sacrament is being properly safeguarded and that such Eucharistic ministry to the homebound takes place in full accordance with our Diocesan Sacramental Policies.

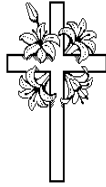

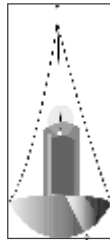
