#### **RCIA**

Are you or someone you know interested in becoming a Catholic? As we approach the end of summer it's time to gauge interest and gather names for the 2022-2023 year of RCIA classes (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) here at the Cathedral.

Technically speaking, the RCIA program is an intellectual and spiritual journey for those individuals who have never been baptized, but are interested in exploring the teachings of the Catholic faith in view of potentially seeking baptism and entrance into the full life of the Church next Easter. But I also find that RCIA classes can also serve as helpful formation for those non-Catholic Christians who are already baptized, but are considering "converting" to the Catholic faith by being received into full communion with the Catholic Church.

Depending on interest, I am hoping to host these RCIA CLASSES ON WEDNESDAY EVENINGS FROM 5:30 TO 6:30PM HERE AT THE CATHEDRAL STARTING ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 15<sup>TH</sup>.

Each week, we'll cover one "bite-sized" topic related to faith, morals, history, prayer and spirituality, and other relevant topics. I hope to personally teach the vast majority of these lectures myself, with the assistance of occasional guest lecturers/experts.

No prior connection to the Cathedral is required for these classes, so feel free to spread the news far and wide and invite friends and acquaintances from all around the greater Rochester area.

Don't put it off until next year or hesitate due to fear! And if there is someone in your life that needs an invitation or prompting to encourage them to give it a try—now is the time!




