Here are a few important announcements that I would like to draw to your attention:

Religious Ed and First Holy Communion Sign-ups

Religious Ed. sign ups begin this week! The first day of class will be September 25th.

Classes meet most Sundays from 10:20-11:05 (conveniently in between the 9:15 Mass and the 11:15 Mass). Weekly Sunday Mass attendance is expected for all students and their families.

You can register your child by filling out a paper registration form (available on the Information Desk in the Narthex) or by using the online registration form that is available on our website: sacredheartrochester.org

If your child is in 1st or 2nd grade and is planning on preparing for First Holy Communion, it is especially important that you register him or her for weekly Religious Ed.

First Confession and First Holy Communion are generally received in the month of May by students in second grade.

Confirmation Sign-ups

Confirmation sign ups begin this week as well. In the Diocese of Rochester, Confirmation is a two-year program that generally begins in 8th grade. Confirmation is received no sooner than Spring of one's ninth-grade year.

All confirmation students from last year should re-register for Year 2. Classes will be held most Sundays from 10:20-11:05am

(and of course, Mass attendance every Sunday in required). All who are beginning the program this year in Year 1 (8th graders and above) should register. Please note: Year 1 classes will meet on Sundays from 4:30 to 5:30pm so that I (Fr. Van Lieshout) can teach that class directly. You may use the same registration form as the Religious Ed registration—either paper or online.

New Lectors and Sacristans

Many thanks to all the new volunteers who signed up to be Lectors and Sacristans. But we need to do some introductory training!

Would all the new Lectors be able to meet with me for a short training session next Sunday, September 18th at 10:30am? Likewise, would all the new sacristans be available to meet with me Monday evening, September 19th at 6:30pm?

RCIA begins

Finally, **RCIA begins this Wednesday**, September 14th from 5:30pm-6:30pm. This is an introductory session to layout the plan for the rest of the year. So if you are on the fence about whether or not RCIA is for you...I invite you to at least come and see. We'll meet this first week in the Church itself.
