December 11, 2022 Third Sunday Of Advent

Praised be Jesus Christ!

As many probably already know, "Gaudete Sunday" (the 3rd Sunday of Advent), takes its name from the first line of the Entrance Antiphon for this Mass: "Gaudete in Domino semper; iterum dico, gaudete!"—which translated means: Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice! (Phil 4:4).

I love the fact that the word "Gaudete" is in the form of a command. St. Paul is telling the Philippians (and us): You *must* rejoice!

It seems so counterintuitive to *command* rejoicing, since we generally think of joy as something spontaneous and unprompted—something that flows from us naturally and not something that we can "stir up" at will. And yet the Word of God and the Sacred Liturgy give us this command.

I'm sure that many Church Fathers and saints have commented on this passage and have profound ways to understand this seeming paradox. Without having searched these out, I suspect that at least part of the solution comes from the fact that the kind of joy that St. Paul is speaking of is not something earthly or natural, but flows from the gifts of faith, hope, and charity which abide in the souls of all those who have been renewed in Christ and are in the state of grace.

I can also share what my Scripture professor from college, Dr. John Bergsma, has to say about regarding authentic, Christian joy. Commenting on the line from Isaiah 61, he remarks:

"God is the joy of my soul." How true this is! How often we are tempted to put something else into the "God" slot in that statement: "______ is the joy of my soul." How do we fill in the blank? Money? Success? Caffeine/Alcohol/some other drug? Sex? Football? Some other sport? A hobby? This Sunday is time to rejoice for all those who put "God" in the blank.


