For this week's column, just a few announcements:

CMA – Currently we are about 50% of the way toward our Catholic Ministries Appeal (CMA) goal. For whatever reason, the yearly Diocesan mailing went out a little late this year for our parish, so I hope that parishioners are willing and able to make their contribution quickly. *Please consider making your CMA gift as an expression of your Thanksgiving generosity.*

Blessing of Religious Items – I am frequently asked to bless various religious items and rosaries. I am always happy to do so, but I want to make this opportunity as convenient and available as possible to all of our parishioners. What I am suggesting is that the first Sunday of every month, after all the Masses, I will be available to do blessings of religious items and also enrollment in the Brown Scapular. We will try to put a reminder in the bulletin one week in advance each month. These blessings will take place in the Narthex immediately after Mass. *The next blessings will take place on the weekend of December 2nd and 3rd*.

Family Rosary and Pot Luck – I had a suggestion from a parishioner that we institute a monthly "Family Rosary and Potluck" here at the Cathedral. I love the idea, and I think it would be especially beneficial immediately following the 11:15 Sunday Mass. *Can we try an initial attempt on December 3rd after the 11:15 Mass?* We will meet downstairs in the Cathedral hall immediately following the Mass, pray the rosary together, and share a potluck lunch. I would love this as an opportunity for various couples and families to get to know each other better in our growing Cathedral Community.
