I'm so happy to announce that we successfully reached our CMA goal for this year, and I am doubly-pleased by the fact that we reached our goal much more quickly than in my previous two years.

Thank you so much to all those individuals and families for the support that you've shown. It reflects well on our Cathedral parish in cooperating with our Bishop (who is the true "Pastor" of our parish) and also in caring for the greater needs of our Diocesan church of Rochester. Selfishly, it also reflects well on me as the Rector, and allows me to breathe a sigh of relief, saying, "Ah, we did it!"

That said, the actual total number of donors to our parish campaign goal is not quite as high as in past years. I suspect that there are still a good number of people who intend to make your pledge but have not done so yet. Please don't let the fact that we've reached our goal make you hesitate in turning in that pledge!

There are two reasons for this:

- 1. Our Diocese has many important financial needs and it is my opinion that our Cathedral parish (precisely because it is at the spiritual heart of our Diocese) should be uniquely generous in helping to meet them.
- 2. 50% of whatever money is given beyond our parish goal is returned directly back to our parish funds. Therefore, those additional pledges will help us in a very direct way to meet our own very real financial needs.

So keep those pledges coming in! And thank you all again. I am so happy.
