If you are looking for ways to make the most out of this Lent, consider some of the following opportunities at the Cathedral:

<u>Daily Mass</u> – I love to see strong daily Mass attendance during Lent! The lectionary readings throughout the season are such an excellent Scriptural walk towards Easter. And in my experience, daily Mass attendance helps many people to appreciate more fully and prepare for effectively for the Sunday Mass obligation.

<u>Confessions</u> – Our normal schedule has generous confession times available, but stay tuned for an additional **Day of Penance on February 22**nd in which many of the parishes throughout the Diocese will have extra confession times all day long.

<u>Friday Lenten Holy Hour-</u> On *all Fridays of Lent*, there will be a Holy Hour at 3pm with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, concluding with Benediction at 4pm. Come adore Our Lord's Eucharistic and Sacred Heart, really present on our altar!

<u>Stations of the Cross</u>— We will have an abundance of opportunities for Stations of the Cross on Friday of Lent here at the Cathedral.

Immediately following the 12:10 daily Mass, parishioners will lead a Stations of the Cross with Meditations on the Passion of Christ as if seen from the perspective of the Blessed Virgin Mary.




