Lent begins this week!

If you are looking for ways to make the most out of this Lent, consider some of the following opportunities at the Cathedral:

Daily Mass – I love to see strong daily Mass attendance during Lent! The lectionary readings throughout the season are such an excellent Scriptural walk towards Easter. And in my experience, daily Mass attendance helps many people to appreciate more fully and prepare for effectively for the Sunday Mass obligation.

Confessions – Our normal schedule has generous confession times available, but stay tuned for an additional ***Day of Penance on February 22nd*** in which many of the parishes throughout the Diocese will have extra confession times all day long.

Friday Lenten Holy Hour- On ***all Fridays of Lent***, there will be a Holy Hour at 3pm with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, concluding with Benediction at 4pm. Come adore Our Lord's Eucharistic and Sacred Heart, really present on our altar!

Stations of the Cross– We will have an abundance of opportunities for Stations of the Cross on Friday of Lent here at the Cathedral.

Stations of the Cross with Mary

Immediately following the 12:10 daily Mass, parishioners will lead a Stations of the Cross with Meditations on the Passion of Christ as if seen from the perspective of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Solemn Stations of the Cross

Stations of the Cross every Friday afternoon at 5:45pm featuring a variety of beloved “versions” –but especially the famous meditations written by St. Alphonsus Liguori.

“10 Old Testament Scripture Passages That You Just Need To Know” – I will lead this Scripture study on four consecutive Sundays—the first four Sunday's of Lent—from 6:30pm to 8:00pm in the Cathedral Hall. No sign-ups required!

Ashes will be distributed:

7:00 am — Liturgy of the word and distribution of ashes

12:10 pm & 5:20 pm Mass and distribution of ashes

What does the church require of Catholics during Lent?

- Abstinence from meat — Those 14 years of age or older must not eat meat on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent.
- Fasting—Those who are ages 18-59 are to eat one full meal and two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal and not to eat between meals on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.


