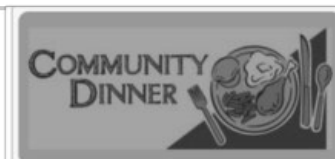
## 10 Old Testament Scripture Passages that you Just need to Know

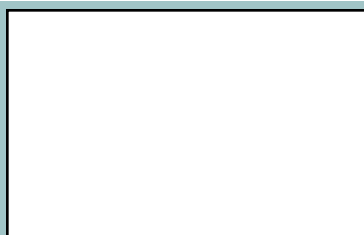

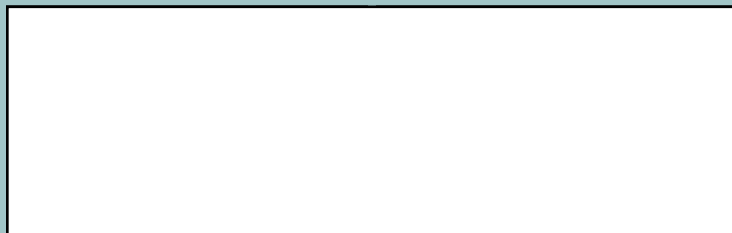
