Please drop off your baked goods on March 17 prior to arriving to the 9:15 am or 11:15 am mass to the kitchen just off of the narthex area.


This tradition comes from Sicily as a way of expressing our gratitude to St. Joseph for his powerful intercession and to place ourselves once again under his spiritual protection.
