Praised be Jesus Christ!

I just received some very exciting news this week and I'm happy to be able to share it with the parish. One of our young men from our parish, Michael Piersall, has been officially accepted as a seminarian for the Diocese of Rochester and will begin his seminary formation in the fall at Our Lady of Providence College Seminary in Providence, Rhode Island.

For the last three years, Michael has been a constant helpful presence around the Cathedral. You probably recognize him best from the fact that he serves regularly at the altar for Sunday and weekday Masses. But Michael has volunteered in many number of ways for our parish, both during his senior year of high school and during school breaks during his first two years of undergraduate studies at Christendom College in Front Royal, Virginia. (I should note also that Michael's mother, Darlene, works in our office as our Religious Education Coordinator).

Michael's acceptance into seminary formation is fruit of several years of prayerful discernment. And while this is only the first step along the long path towards the priesthood, we can rejoice as a parish that the Lord has granted him the graces and generosity of spirit to take this first step!

It is a great honor for any parish to have a seminarian come from "within the pews." It also entails some important responsibilities on our part. We need to make sure that we are praying regularly for Michael and all of our Diocesan seminarians that they be formed into holy priests according to the Heart of Christ and persevere in their good intention. We also should be asking the Lord to bless us with even more seminarians and candidates for the religious life from within our pews and from within our families.

Please say a word of congratulations and support to Michael Piersall and his family when you see them around the Cathedral.

Also, on a personal note...

It doesn't seem to me like so much time has already gone by, but June 21st will be exactly 10 years to the day that I was ordained a priest here in Sacred Heart Cathedral by Bishop Matano.

On the one hand, I am astounded and humbled by all that the Lord has done in and through me during the last half-decade. On the other hand, I identify with the sentiments expressed by St. Francis of Assisi to his friars toward the end of his life when he reportedly told them: "Let us begin again, for as yet we have done nothing."




