Praised be Jesus Christ!

Exactly one week after the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary, the Church celebrates the Memorial of the Queenship of Mary on August 22<sup>nd</sup> (just a daily Mass—not an additional Holy Day of Obligation).

The *Assumption of Mary* and her *Queenship over Heaven and Earth* go hand in hand. Just briefly, here are two reasons:

1. In Revelation 11:19-12:1, John sees the Ark of the Covenant in heaven but immediately describes a vision of a woman who is Mother of the Messiah.

*Then God's temple in heaven was opened, and the ark of his covenant was seen within his temple; and there were flashes of lightning, voices, peals of thunder, an earthquake, and heavy hail. And a great sign appeared in heaven, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.*

This verse hinges on the Biblical typology of Mary as the New Ark of the Covenant (literally, Mary's body is the Ark) and implicitly indicates the presence of Mary's body already in heavenly glory, having been assumed. But notice, *she is described with the imagery of queenship. She is "clothed with the sun" and has on her head a "crown of twelve stars" thus showing her as queen over the 12 tribes of Israel.*

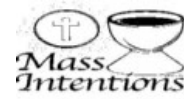
2. The Kingship of Christ implies the Queenship of Mary. In ancient near-eastern Kingdoms, *there was a specific title and role for the "Queen Mother"*—the mother of the reigning King. One of the reasons for this was quite practical. While a King might have many wives, he could only have one mother.

We know that this was true of the Davidic Kingdom of the Old Testament. When David's son Solomon was reigning as King, his Mother Bathsheba had an intercessory role on behalf of the people viz-a-viz her son the King. People could bring to her their petitions and she would present them to the King, adding additional "force" to the petition on account of her maternal authority.

See, for example, 1 Kings 2 when Bathsheba approaches her son Solomon with a request. It says: "And the king rose to meet her, and bowed down to her; then he sat on his throne, and had a seat brought for the king's mother; and she sat on his right" (v. 19). *As Christ is the fulfillment of the Davidic Kingship, so too does his Mother Mary exercise the fulfillment in heaven of this Queen-Mother role. And just as Solomon rose from his throne to greet his mother and escort her to her royal place at his side, so too can the Assumption of Mary be seen as Christ arising to take his Blessed Mother into heaven, body and soul, to reign at his side in her Heavenly Queenship.*

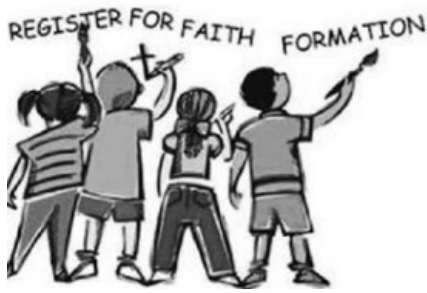
