Praised be Jesus Christ!

We are still a few weeks out from Ash Wednesday, but I would like to start publicizing an Adult Education opportunity that I have planned for the first weeks of Lent.

Two winters ago I did a 4-week apologetic series called Defending Theism, in which I taught several useful arguments for the existence of God. Last Lent I did a 4-week series called 10 Old Testament Passage You Just Need to Know. In both cases I was very pleased with the attendance, discussion and questions.

In this Jubilee Year of 2025, the Church is encouraging organized studies of the documents of the Second Vatican Council—even to the point of extending an indulgence to those who participate in them:

[T]he faithful will be able to obtain the Jubilee Indulgence if, with a devout spirit, they participate in popular missions, spiritual exercises, or formation activities on the documents of the Second Vatican Council and the Catechism of the Catholic Church, held in a church or other suitable place, according to the mind of the Holy Father. (from the Decree on the Granting of the Indulgence During the Ordinary Jubilee Year of 2025)

This year marks the 60th Anniversary of the close of the Second Vatican Council, and if I can be perfectly honest, I'm a little tired of now decades of parish adult education studies and lectures giving unique attention to this particular Council. I often think: "There are 20 other Ecumenical Councils in the history of the Church, why don't we ever do parish studies on those?" (When was the last time a parish announced in the bulletin an in-depth study of the Third Council of Constantinople or the Second Council of Lyon?!)

Be that as it is, I will be a faithful son of the Church and devise my Lenten series accordingly. But I want to make it interesting and theologically deep. So I am proposing the following:

Blessing of Religious Items


Blessing of religious items will take place the weekend of February 22 & 23, a table will be located in the narthex.


