Last Sunday at Mass, Saint Paul's words to the Corinthians reminded us that, regardless of our vocations, we are called to renewal in our own lives, particularly during this Lenten season: "Whoever is in Christ is a new creation: the old things have passed away; behold, new things have come. And all this is from God...." (2 Corinthians 5:17-18).



This will take place on Tuesday, April 15, 2025, at 6:00 pm at Sacred Heart Cathedral, 296 Flower City Park, 14615.




UPDATE on Tenebrae Morning Prayer


