

## January 14, 2024 - Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

### THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD



Last week, as a Church we celebrated the other great feast day of the Christmas season: the Epiphany. While we are now back in Ordinary Time, normally the week after the Epiphany is the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord. However, because the Epiphany was late this year, the Feast of the Baptism was held last Monday, which was the official end to the Christmas season. Even though the celebration is over, I wanted to speak to this feast day, because I think it often gets overlooked, either due to it sometimes falling on Monday, or that it takes place so long after Christmas.

Now, you might be asking, and with good reason, why the Baptism of the Lord is the feast day that ends the Christmas season? After all, the Christmas season deals with the story of Jesus' birth. Over the last couple of Sundays, we have been hearing stories of the beginning of Jesus' life, the events that occurred right before and right after he was born. But we know, of course, that Jesus was not baptized by John when he was a child. Both John and Jesus, who were born within the same year of each other, are adults when this scene takes place, which means that many years have passed from the time that Jesus was born.

The reason why the Church chose this event as the end of the Christmas season is actually a very simple one. It is because all of the Gospels agree that Jesus' baptism is the event that began his public ministry. Up until this time, he had been a man living in relative obscurity: no miracles, no sermons, no healings, etc. In many ways, it is this event that separates the private Jesus from the public Jesus. Remember, with the exception of a brief story in Luke about the 12-year-old Jesus in Jerusalem, there is nothing in the Gospels about Jesus' life from the time he is an infant until he is baptized and begins his public ministry as an adult. Thus, the Church uses this event as way to close the book on the Christmas season ("private" life) and begin Ordinary Time (public ministry). From here on, the Gospel passages in Mass focus back on the ministry period of Jesus' life.

The Baptism of Jesus is important for more reasons than just ending the Christmas season. We know that the Baptism Jesus received is not the Baptism that Jesus handed down to his Apostles. Remember, John himself said that his baptism was only of water, while Jesus' baptism would be with the Holy Spirit. Not only that, but Jesus doesn't even need to be baptized. He is the author of Baptism, not a receiver of baptism. Yet, he still received this baptism by John. This action does two things: it shows how, even though he isn't a sinner, he still identifies with sinners (something he would do throughout his ministry); and his reception of Baptism would be the example that all of his disciples would follow until the end of time.

Baptism is the very first sacrament we receive as a member of the Church. It marks the beginning of our relationship with God as our "Father," wipes away any sin that came before it, and is the only certain way that we know of for entering into heaven. In allowing himself to be Baptized by John, Jesus showed us the way toward salvation.
