In the church, People Frances tells us, 'everything begins with baptism.' The anointing with Sacred Chrism at our baptism is as Jesus was anointed, "Priest, Prophet and King." We become a new member of the Christian community called to pray, to preach and to be a servant for others. The earthly ministry of Jesus began at his baptism by John and ended with the Last Supper with his friends.



The Gospel today is part of the Winter Ordinary Time series when we see a portrait of Jesus' public ministry as he shared meals, made friendships, healed the sick and performed miracles, signs and wonders! In our gospel this weekend, we witness Jesus "teaching with authority." As Jesus taught as well as listened to their questions and concerns, the people came to realize that Jesus is speaking the truth. His ultimate mission on this earth was to preach the truth and to bring others to see him clearly as their Messiah, their Savior.

The National Eucharistic Revival is given to us by the church to renew our beautiful relationship with our Lord and Savior. We have the Holy Mass, the Word and the Blessed Eucharist keeping us close to the Lord. The revival helps us to "respond to Our Lord's personal, loving two-fold invitation: to remain with him in the Eucharist at Mass and in prayer and to go out with him on mission for the life of the world!" "Jesus is present, reminding us that he is more powerful than the storm. He desires to heal, renew, and unify the Church and the world."

Pope Francis encourages us to "continue our efforts to contribute to a revival of faith in, and love for, the Holy Eucharist."



As Sister Parishes, we are blessed to participate in both the **National Eucharistic Revival and the Synod on Synodality**. As we collaborate in so many beautiful ways, we are learning to listen with our hearts for the Spirit's call as we journey to the future, **together as one**. The two movements compliment the other in that the Eucharist sends us into the world for mission and our mission is to be a loving community of believers.


- 230 Holy Spirit parishioners have pledged \$92,034

# Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

February 3-4, 2024 Mark 1:29-39

On leaving the synagogue Jesus entered the house of Simon and Andrew with James and John. Simon's mother-in-law lay sick with a fever. They immediately told him about her. He approached, grasped her hand, and helped her up. Then the fever left her and she waited on them. When it was evening, after sunset, they brought to him all who were ill or possessed by demons. The whole town was gathered at the door. He cured many who were sick with various diseases, and he drove out many demons, not permitting them to speak because they knew him. Rising very early before dawn, he left and went off to a deserted place, where he prayed. Simon and those who were with him pursued him and on finding him said, "Everyone is looking for you." He told them, "Let us go on to the nearby villages that I may preach there also. For this purpose have I come." So he went into their synagogues, preaching and driving out demons throughout the whole of Galilee.
