

September 28-29 2024 Mk 9:38-43, 45, 47-48

At that time, John said to Jesus, "Teacher, we saw someone driving out demons in your name, and we tried to prevent him because he does not follow us." Jesus replied, "Do not prevent him. There is no one who performs a mighty deed in my name who can at the same time speak ill of me. For whoever is not against us is for us. Anyone who gives you a cup of water to drink because you belong to Christ, amen, I say to you, will surely not lose his reward. "Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him if a great millstone were put around his neck and he were thrown into the sea. If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter into life maimed than with two hands to go into Gehenna, into the unquenchable fire. 





A REMEMBRANCE OF JACK SKVORAK (11/2/34-8/22/24)



Sometimes we come across some very special people in our lives. Those who truly make a difference in the world. They don't see doing the right thing as a choice, but

as a responsibility. Jack Skvorak was one of those people. As founder of the Tanzania Action Team, along with his wife Mary, they helped St. Joseph's and Holy Spirit become aware of the needs of our global neighbors in Tanzania. The compassion he felt for Father Damian's students was felt by all and it opened our hearts as well. Over the last 13 years \$447,130 was donated by our Parishes for students' tuitions, new construction and upkeep of Father Damian's schools. Jack knew the importance of people seeing firsthand why our contributions are so necessary and impelled 14 parishioners (including Father Jim) to travel to Tanzania. Jack had a long list of social outreach & social justice issues he was involved with, but we are especially fortunate that the Tanzania Action Team was among them. He will be missed.






