## INTRODUCING OUR NEW PASTORAL ASSOCIATE, TERESA DUNN

When our joint parish staff met in August, it was clear that there were opportunities to further meet the needs of Holy Spirit and St. Joseph's parishioners and to fill some gaps in day-to-day ministries. In late August, we posted a job opening and description of responsibilities with the Diocese of Rochester, and scheduled time for interviews following Fr. Jim's retreat. When Fr. Jim, Fr. Mike, and myself met with Teresa Dunn we knew the Holy Spirit was at work and we had found a faith-filled candidate who is committed to parish ministry. She starts October 15.

Teresa comes to us after close to four years as pastoral associate at St. Benedict's (St. Mary's and St. Bridget's) in Canandaigua. She completed her Master of Arts and Pastoral Studies at St. Bernard's School of Theology and Ministry in 2022.

About her time at St. Benedict's, Teresa wrote: "I grew to know and love many in the community and I was blessed to walk with others on their journey toward a deeper relationship with Christ." In accepting the position with us, she said "I am very excited about the opportunity to become part of a new community of faith, fellowship, and love with the Holy Spirit and St. Joseph parishes."

The job responsibilities for this position will include:

- *Worship:* Helping to recruit and train liturgical ministers, she also will work to develop a joint Worship team, will communicate weekly with liturgical ministers, and assist with funeral planning.
- *Stewardship:* With a focus on time and talent, Teresa will assist our leadership teams with recruitment, finding solutions that best meet the needs of varied ministries.
- *Adult Formation:* Teresa and Fr. Mike are committed to developing a young adult ministry at our parishes; she will also work on adult formation programs and journey with our candidates and catechumens in the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults.
- *Pastoral Care*: Teresa will have an active weekend presence at both parishes, and will work with the Pastoral Care team on visitation to the homebound.

When Teresa joined the pastoral staff at St. Benedict's in 2020, her first parish assignment, Fr. Mike Costik reached out and asked me to be a mentor to her. What started with a few Zoom calls at the height of the pandemic led to endless hours of discussion and sharing about our mutual love of ministry over the past four years. I know that our two parishes will be blessed by her presence; let us pray that the Lord will bless Teresa in her ministry.

# TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

October 12-13 2024 Mk 10:17-30

As Jesus was setting out on a journey, a man ran up, knelt down before him, and asked him, "Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus answered him, "Why do you call me good? No one is good but God alone. You know the commandments: You shall not kill; you shall not commit adultery; you shall not steal; you shall not bear false witness; you shall not defraud; honor your father and your mother." He replied and said to him, "Teacher, all of these I have observed from my youth." Jesus, looking at him, loved him and said to him, "You are lacking in one thing. Go, sell what you have, and give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me." At that statement his face fell, and he went away sad, for he had many possessions. Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, "How hard it is for those who have wealth to enter the kingdom of God!" The disciples were amazed at his words. So Jesus again said to them in reply, "Children, how hard it is to enter the kingdom of God! It is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle than for one who is rich to enter the kingdom of God." They were exceedingly astonished and said among themselves, "Then who can be saved?" Jesus looked at them and said, "For human beings it is impossible, but not for God. All things are possible for God." Peter began to say to him, "We have given up everything and followed you." Jesus said, "Amen, I say to you, there is no one who has given up house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or lands for my sake and for the sake of the gospel who will not receive a hundred times more now in this present age: houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions, and eternal life in the age to come."





# BISHOPS URGE US TO VOTE 'NO' ON NEW YORK STATE ERA

## What changes are being proposed?

The Equal Rights Amendment (Proposal One on November's ballot) would add new language to the New York State Constitution (Article 1, Section 11). The NEW proposed language is in CAPITAL letters:

A - "No person shall be denied the equal protection of the laws of this state or any subdivision thereof. No person shall, because of race, color, ETHNICITY, NATIONAL ORIGIN, AGE, DISABILITY, creed [or], religion, OR SEX, INCLUDING SEXUAL ORIENTATION, GENDER IDENTITY, GENDER EXPRESSION, PREGNANCY, PREGNANCY OUTCOMES, AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTHCARE AND AUTONOMY, be subjected to any discrimination in [his or her] THEIR civil rights by any other person or by any firm, corporation, or institution, or by the state or any agency or subdivision of the state, PURSUANT to law."

B - "NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL INVALIDATE OR PREVENT THE ADOPTION OF ANY LAW, REGULATION, PROGRAM, OR PRACTICE THAT IS DESIGNED TO PREVENT OR DISMANTLE DISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF A CHARACTERISTIC LISTED IN THIS SECTION, NOR SHALL ANY CHARACTERISTIC LISTED IN THIS SECTION BE INTERPRETED TO INTERFERE WITH, LIMIT, OR DENY THE CIVIL RIGHTS OF ANY PERSON BASED UPON ANY OTHER CHARACTERISTIC IDENTIFIED IN THIS SECTION."

#### What could this do?

- Loosen age-appropriate restrictions
- Enshrine abortion up until birth in the NYS Constitution
- Allow children to make life-altering medical decisions without parental consent
- Erode freedom of religious protections


