FAITHFUL CITIZENSHIP



As Catholics and Americans, we are blessed to be able to participate in our nation's political and public life. Our love for this country, our patriotism calls us to vote. It is not for the Church to tell you which candidate to vote for, but it is very appropriate for us as a Church to speak to ethical issues that speak to the dignity of all human life and provide for the common good.

As our bishops point out in the document FORMING CONSCIENCES FOR FAITHFUL CITIZENSHIP, "It seems election seasons are a time of anxiety and spiritual trial. Political rhetoric is increasingly angry, seeking to motivate through division and hatred...the most heated arguments online often get the most clicks. Demonizing the other can win votes."



Our bishops in this document call us to have a moral framework that instills the hope of binding these wounds and healing these bitter divisions. May we as a Church proclaim the timeless principles of the dignity of every human life and the value of working together to provide for the common good.

As to the ethical issues embedded in Proposition One, known as the Equal Rights Amendment, our bishops encourage us to vote no. Why? This proposition enshrines in the state constitution the right to abortion on demand. It does not provide equal rights for the child in the womb of his mother. Secondly, the proposition bans parental involvement in their minor son or daughter seeking to make a most significant decision in gender transition.

Yes, we seek to love and listen to all children who wrestle with gender identity and their self-worth in this precious moment of the life cycle, but we also value parental responsibility and love and guidance for their sons and daughters.

May God bless you as you consider and pray over all the challenging decisions in the voting process. May God bless our nation with true wisdom, peace, and mutual forgiveness, that we may decide together, through our democratic processes, to uphold the dignity of life and the common good.

May God give you peace.

In the course of his teaching Jesus said to the crowds, "Beware of the scribes, who like to go around in long robes and accept greetings in the marketplaces, seats of honor in synagogues, and places of honor at banquets. They devour the houses of widows and, as a pretext recite lengthy prayers. They will receive a very severe condemnation."

He sat down opposite the treasury and observed how the crowd put money into the treasury. Many rich people put in large sums. A poor widow also came and put in two small coins worth a few cents. Calling his disciples to himself, he said to them, "Amen, I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury. For they have all contributed from their surplus wealth, but she, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood."



Social Outreach

CARING FOR GOD’S CREATION BY RECYCLING RIGHT (CONT.)

In keeping with God's call to Care for Creation, because recycling is dependent on finding markets for the products, it can be changeable and confusing. Much of the recycling collected in our county goes to the Monroe County Recycling Center. However, instructions vary slightly with different carriers, so you may want to check with your own collection service.

All materials to be recycled should be empty, clean and unbagged. Plastic bags should never be put in residential bins since they tangle up the automated sorting process. You do not need to remove any labels. Lids, screwed onto the recyclables should also go into the bin. It's best to leave can lids attached or crush them inside the can. Corrugated cardboard is in such demand right now, that even the greasy bottoms of your pizza boxes can go in the bin, just remove any food.



The next few weeks will outline instructions for residential recycling.
