

December 8, 2024 Second Sunday of Advent

A Day in the Life of Phillip the Van



It's early in the morning—most people are at work, and the kids are arriving to school, when I begin my day. I stay warm and dry in my own garage, and the folks arrive to wake me up about 7:45. I'm an older van, so they take good care of me. I usually have two humans inside me, safe behind their protective cage, as we head over to the Wegmans store. I pull up to the loading dock and there is usually a lot of food to load—50 or more banana boxes—maybe 950 lbs. A volunteer has usually begun the process of putting the boxes on the dock. Let me tell you, that food is heavy, and the Wegmans stuff fills me more than $\frac{3}{4}$ full. Then I stop off at Target and load 15-20 more boxes. It can be all sorts of stuff: prepared meals, bread of

every kind, bagels, vegetables, fruit, salad, drinks, eggs, etc. I keep careful track of everything that is loaded, because the government wants a record.

Once I'm full, the fun begins. Now you may be asking why a van is writing a column for this parish bulletin. First, I represent our parish wherever I go—a white panel van carrying food for those who are hungry and can't afford to buy enough for their families. Second, I'm the one who does the real work. The humans think they are doing the heavy lifting, but they just load and unload. I carry the food miles and miles around the City. Let's see if they can do that!

Anyway, our first stop is at Penfield Hope. Their building is small, so they have to be careful what they take. Maybe one day they could expand their site so they could serve more people. I appreciate what they have done with their parking lot; it's a lot more comfortable for me to work my way in there.

Then it's off the races. Down the road, on the highway, across to the exit that takes us off Portland Ave where I pull off onto the sidewalk to our next stop. They are always ready to unload the food—the guy who drives, and especially the guy who rides shotgun, don't have to do much. They know what they need so their shelves can be full. If they have a lot of bread, they won't take any. I like carrying bread; it's light, except for the big bags of sub rolls...HEAVY!

My next stop is Bethany House, a shelter for families run by the Catholic Worker community. Their site is full of construction, so I have to sit on Joseph Avenue while all the cars go by. Sometimes I think I might lose a door to a passing car. But I like stopping there because I know they will be using the food to help families in crisis.

My next stop is Rochester Hope, at St. Michael's church. They unload a bunch of food because they have lots of folks on Saturdays who come and shop (free) for their families. People from our parish help once a month on a Saturday, assisting the shoppers. They come out with carts, which I like to see because it means I am getting lighter. All of the folks look forward to my coming each day; lots of smiles and "thanks." Just think how much good will I bring from our parish to theirs.

My final stop is at Sr. Regis food cupboard. If my helpers get distracted, or talking too much, I can be late to Sr. Regis. Sr. Regis doesn't like it if I'm late. Sr. Regis will call on the cell phone to see why I am late and when I am coming. Don't mess with Sr. Regis. Did I make that clear. She never gets impatient with me, it's the blockheads in the front

seats who catch it. By the way, I shouldn't call them "blockheads." They really are good folks, most of the time. Volunteers are always needed to help me serve the poor. Could you give a few hours once a month to help me help the poor and hungry? Call the office. I don't have a phone.

Call them.

The crowds asked John the Baptist, "What should we do?" He said to them in reply, "Whoever has two cloaks should share with the person who has none. And whoever has food should do likewise." Even tax collectors came to be baptized and they said to him, "Teacher, what should we do?" He answered them, "Stop collecting more than what is prescribed." Soldiers also asked him, "And what is it that we should do?" He told them, "Do not practice extortion, do not falsely accuse anyone, and be satisfied with your wages."

Now the people were filled with expectation, and all were asking in their hearts whether John might be the Christ. John answered them all, saying, "I am baptizing you with water, but one mightier than I is coming. I am not worthy to loosen the thongs of his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing fan is in his hand to clear his threshing floor and to gather the wheat into his barn, but the chaff he will burn with unquenchable fire." Exhorting them in many other ways, he preached good news to the people.
