May 4, 2025 - Third Sunday of Easter

“FEED MY SHEEP.”



In this Sunday’s Easter season Gospel, Jesus appears for a third time to the disciples. Three times Jesus asks Simon Peter if he loves him. Each time, Peter responds that Jesus must know that he loves him. And three times, Jesus then says either: “Feed my lambs” or “tend my sheep” or “feed my sheep.”

Peter would, of course, become the first leader of the Church. Jesus didn’t command Peter to pen the catechism or build a basilica. Jesus told Peter to tend to the sheep – messy, hungry, lost sheep.

Every Pope since is a successor of Peter. How fitting then, that the late Pope Francis, would have such an intense focus on this command of Jesus to focus on the sheep, to be a Pastor, to be a Shepherd. In fact, Pope Francis chose this same Gospel for his funeral Mass. Since the passing of our Holy Father on Easter Monday, April 21, I have heard ordinary people like ourselves, and Church leaders, express the sentiment that the pastoral leadership of Pope Francis changed them. That is true for me, too.

In 2015, Jeanne Mooney and I had the privilege of attending the World Meeting of Families in Philadelphia. We were able to attend the Mass that Pope Francis presided at and preached, and we got to see him go by in the “pope-mobile” in the streets of Philadelphia.

That was just before the Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy began, a time when the St. Joseph’s Parish Council listened to Pope Francis’ call to encounter the poor, to feed and tend to God’s sheep. Each of us participated in hands-on social ministries that year and some of us started to explore how we could better serve people seeking food and financial help from the parish. With the help of our friends at Webster Hope, by the end of the Year of Mercy, we were getting ready to form Penfield Hope.

How amazing it is that Pope Francis not only went home to the Lord on Easter Monday but also during this Jubilee Year of Hope. The Scripture passage that guides this Jubilee Year is Romans 5:5 – “Hope does not disappoint.” In the papal bull that announced the Jubilee Year of Hope, Pope Francis expanded on this theme: “Everyone knows what it is to hope. In the heart of each person, hope dwells as the desire and expectation of good things to come, despite our not knowing what the future may bring.”

Every day in our pastoral ministry at our sister parishes, and for those of us who serve people at Penfield Hope or Webster Hope, or now Rochester Hope, we encounter people who are desperately holding on to that hope that dwells within their own hearts, as Pope Francis described. In whatever ways each of us lives our faith, may we always remember that feeding and tending to the sheep of our day is what the Lord calls us to do. When we forget, we have so many memories and images to call upon of the hope
-filled examples that Pope Francis gave us throughout his life. Hope does not disappoint.

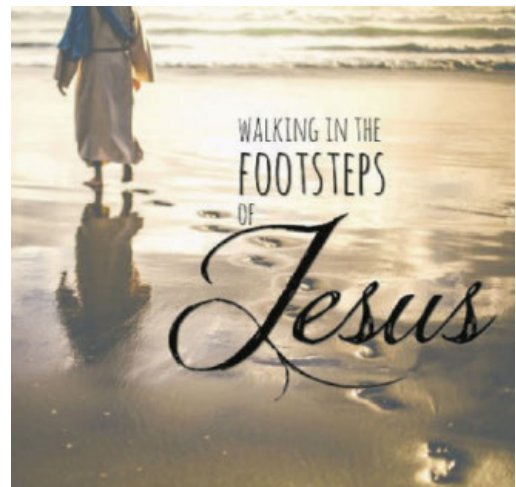

JOINT PARISH COUNCIL

NEXT JOINT PARISH COUNCIL MEETING: May 13, 7pm at Holy Spirit

Highlights from the last Joint Parish Council meeting, February 11:

In addition to the Pastor's Report and updates on Lenten and Easter activities, parishioner Tim Mason was invited to talk with the Council about engaging in a visioning process:

- Tim invited the Council to engage in a months-long process of developing a vision, mission, and goals for our parishes, asking the question: Where are we as a Council leading the parish?
- The goal would be to develop a single-page living document that addresses where we envision ourselves in 3 – 5 years.
- The goals, which might start with some of the priorities the Council has set, such as evangelization, would also “go bigger” to look at engagement and other key areas.
- Synodal listening needs to be a critical part of this process – how do we listen to all parishioners, especially those we are trying to engage, how do we give ownership to the whole parish?
- The process includes an initial SWOT analysis with Council members followed by work on vision, mission, and goals development and success measures. [The SWOT session was held during Lent and the Council will continue with vision, mission, and goals on May 13.]

Fr. Jim shared that he sees four qualities as critical to a visioning process:

- We are Christ-centered and always strive to be more Christ-centered.
- We are always promoting a greater sense of community.
- We are synodal, more and more listening. We are a big tent with many ways to express our spirituality.
- We are pilgrims of hope, like the theme of this Jubilee Year.

Holy Spirit celebrating 60 years in 2025—looking forward as a rooted, Eucharistic community!

Bishop Matano will celebrate Mass on Pentecost, Saturday July 7 at 4pm. There will be a celebration following.

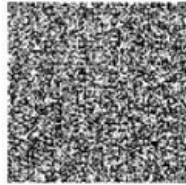
BUILD WITH US AT PENFIELD HABITAT

I'm pleased to report that the Penfield Church Coalition for Habitat is about to break ground on another Habitat Home. This is the 3rd house we've co-sponsored since Feb. 2023 when we joined forces with other faith-based groups across Monroe County to form the Greater Rochester Interfaith Builders.

We've increased the frequency of our sponsored home builds from 18 months to under 12 months and this wouldn't be possible without your support through tithing, donations to our clothing sheds, and fundraisers including our Thanksgiving Pie Sale, annual Yard Sale held in August each year, and various Panera fundraisers throughout the year.

We're excited to announce that, starting with this upcoming home build, we've made it easier for you to come out and build with us! Come work alongside other members of the St. Joseph's / Holy Spirit community and the Penfield Church Coalition.

Please note that you must be at least 16 yrs old. Registration does not immediately commit you to a workday, but does show you available workdays for our group and allows you to sign up. If we are able to commit 5-8 workers, we will be assigned to work on the Greater Rochester Interfaith home but we ask for your understanding if, for some reason, plans change and you are asked to work on a different home.

At this time, the Penfield Coalition has requested 8 spots be reserved for Saturday, May 31 and Wednesday, June 18 from 9 am – 4pm. The May 31st date is available for sign-up now, and the June 18th date will go live around April 18th. If we're successful in filling these volunteer construction spots, we'll announce more in the coming months.

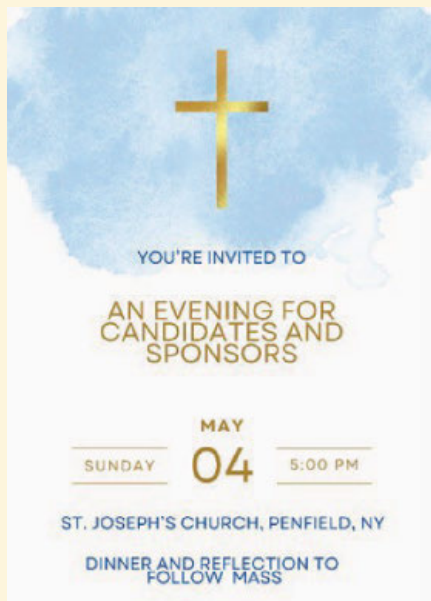

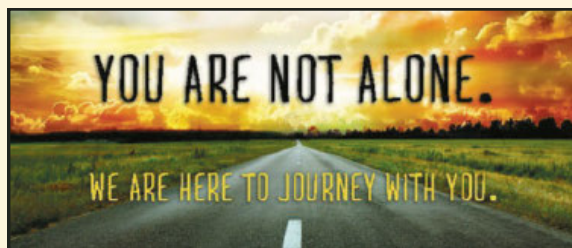
