

The Lyell Avenue area is a neighborhood dealing with many serious issues, among them poverty, drug dealing, prostitution, and violence. **St. Joseph's Northside** is a ministry that provides a safe haven for neighbors to come have a meal, connect with others, and learn about resources that could help get their lives on track. It is next door to Holy Apostles Church and is open from 9am-2pm Tuesday through Friday. A hot breakfast is served on Tuesday and coffee and snacks are available the other days. The ministry was begun in 2005 by the Sisters of St. Joseph, who continue to support it. We too will support it this weekend with our parish sharing.

DIocese of Rochester PERMANENT DIACONATE PROGRAM

The deacon is a man of faith, who is called from the community that already recognizes his dedication to service. He makes a lifetime commitment to serving the People of God by proclaiming the Word, assisting and presiding at liturgies, and ministering in the areas of charity and social justice. A deacon gives witness to his availability to the community by addressing present and emerging needs of the Church.

The Diocese is inviting interested men of strong and active faith, who can demonstrate a record of service in the communities in which they live, work and worship, who may wish to explore a possible call to ordained ministry as a permanent deacon, to first speak with their pastor (Fr. John) for an initial conversation. They may also contact Deacon Edward Giblin, Director of the Office of the Permanent Diaconate, by e-mail (edward.giblin@dor.org) for additional information. A potential candidate must be at least 35 years of age and no older than 62 years of age at the time of ordination after a five (5) year period of formation. He must be in good health, emotionally mature, have stable relationships and must have the wholehearted support of his wife (if married) and family to enter the phase of inquiry. Because the parish is the primary experience of Church for most inquirers, the parish community is asked as well to invite from among its members men who exhibit strong faith and a spirit of service and encourage them to consider a possible vocation to the permanent diaconate.

Updated Protocols (as of July 4, 2021)

The Diocese of Rochester has issued updated guidelines to its parishes in light of the governor's June 15 order lifting COVID-19 restrictions in New York State. Below we have outlined these updates and how St. Charles Borromeo will proceed at this time.

- Consistent with the State's implementation of the recent CDC guidance, masks are still required for **unvaccinated** individuals.
- If you are fully vaccinated, masks are no longer required. *(It is your choice as to whether to wear one or not.)*
- At St. Charles, we will offer a section of "social distancing" seating for those who wish to maintain distancing. The "social distancing" section will be the area closest to Dewey Avenue.
- Holy Communion will continue to be distributed only in the form of the Sacred Host. Please remember to sanitize hands before receiving Communion.
- Holy water fonts located at the doors will remain empty at this time.
- We have reintroduced congregational singing for the Mass parts only.
- We will continue to practice the modified expression of the Sign of Peace with no physical handshaking, but with a greeting and/or wave to each other.
- All Church entrances are available now (Dewey Avenue doors will remain "Exit Only" at this time). The ushers have begun taking up the weekly collection. Thank you for your patience and support!

Readings for September 26, 2021 • 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time

1st Reading (Numbers 11:25-29)

The LORD came down in the cloud and spoke to Moses. Taking some of the spirit that was on Moses, the LORD bestowed it on the seventy elders; and as the spirit came to rest on them, they prophesied.

Now two men, one named Eldad and the other Medad, were not in the gathering but had been left in the camp. They too had been on the list, but had not gone out to the tent; yet the spirit came to rest on them also, and they prophesied in the camp. So, when a young man quickly told Moses, "Eldad and Medad are prophesying in the camp," Joshua, son of Nun, who from his youth had been Moses' aide, said, "Moses, my lord, stop them." But Moses answered him, "Are you jealous for my sake? Would that all the people of the LORD were prophets! Would that the LORD might bestow his spirit on them all!"

2nd Reading (James 5:1-6)

Come now, you rich, weep and wail over your impending miseries. Your wealth has rotted away, your clothes have become moth-eaten, your gold and silver have corroded, and that corrosion will be a testimony against you; it will devour your flesh like a fire. You have stored up treasure of the last days. Behold, the wages you withheld from the workers who harvested your fields are crying aloud; and the cries of the harvesters have reached the ears of the Lord of hosts. You have lived on earth in luxury and pleasure; you have fattened your hearts for the day of slaughter. You have condemned; you have murdered the righteous one; he offers you no resistance.

Gospel (Mark 9:38-43,45,47-48)

At that time, John said to Jesus, "Teacher, we saw someone driving out demons in your name, and we tried to prevent him because he does not follow us." Jesus replied, "Do not prevent him. There is no one who performs a mighty deed in my name who can at the same time speak ill of me. For whoever is not against us is for us. Anyone who gives you a cup of water to drink because you belong to Christ, amen, I say to you, will surely not lose his reward.

"Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him if a great millstone were put around his neck and he were thrown into the sea. If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter into life maimed than with two hands to go into Gehenna, into the unquenchable fire. And if your foot causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter into life crippled than with two feet to be thrown into Gehenna. And if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out. Better for you to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye than with two eyes to be thrown into Gehenna, where 'their worm does not die, and the fire is not quenched.'"




