From the
Pastor's Desk

Dear friends in Christ,

Passiontide is well underway and Holy Week, and the Sacred Triduum are upon us already. Thinking back to the earliest days and weeks of the pandemic, when fear and uncertainty flooded our souls, I am filled with gratitude that we may gather for the celebration of the highest holy days of the year. There are many processions that take place during Holy Week. We begin this weekend with the procession with palms signifying the triumphant entrance of Our Lord into the Holy City of Jerusalem.

On Holy Thursday, we have a Eucharistic procession that commemorates Jesus going to the Garden of Olives and there exhorting His disciples to stay awake and pray. The Eucharist is reposed in a tabernacle after the Mass of the Lord's Supper giving us all an opportunity to be present to the Lord as we contemplate all He endured to free us from sin and give us the hope of eternal life. A minor procession also takes place in this liturgy when the oils that have been blessed by the Bishop at the Chrism Mass are brought forward at the time of the offertory.

On Good Friday, we have the procession with the unveiling of the Crucifix giving us an opportunity to meditate upon the sufferings of Christ. This liturgy is particularly stark as all furnishings, decorations, statues, flowers, and banners are removed from the sanctuary giving us a real sense of that time when Jesus went down into death and left His disciples and even His own Mother with a sense of terrible desolation and despair.

The most solemn celebration of the year, the Easter Vigil begins with the Blessing of the Fire and the preparation of the Easter Candle. A procession into the church is then led by the Easter Candle. The church which is shrouded in darkness is pierced by the light of the Easter Candle signifying Christ, who by rising from the dead dispels the darkness of sin suffering and even death itself.

Finally, our one catechumen Stephen, is brought forward to process to the baptismal font during the singing of the litany of the saints. Stephen will then be baptized, confirmed, and receive First Holy Communion. Please keep Stephen in your prayers, as well as Ryan, who will also be confirmed and receive the Eucharist for the first time. It is my hope that many members of our parish family will join us for the celebration of all the liturgies that make up the Sacred Triduum. Grace be with you all,

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on June 19, 2020, The Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse, New York, (“Diocese”) filed for protection under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”).

The Bankruptcy Court has established April 15, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time) as the deadline to file proofs of claim against the Diocese (the “Bar Date”).

If you have a claim against the Diocese including, without limitation, a claim related to sexual abuse committed by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim on or before the Bar Date with Stretto, the appointed Claims Agent.

IF YOU DO NOT TIMELY FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM, YOU MAY FORFEIT YOUR RIGHT TO VOTE ON ANY PLAN OF REORGANIZATION AND TO SHARE IN ANY FUTURE DISTRIBUTIONS TO CREDITORS IN CONNECTION WITH THE DIOCESE’S CHAPTER 11 CASE.

- ◆ The Liturgy of Palm Sunday of the Lord’s Passion has two distinct themes. First, there is a sense of joy as we commemorate Jesus’ triumphal entry into Jerusalem. This joy, however, is short-lived. Soon most of those who shouted “Hosanna to the Son of David!” and “Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!” call for Jesus to be put to death. After the procession, at the Collect and Liturgy of the Word, the emphasis for the remainder of the Mass shifts to the Passion and Death of Christ and the tone becomes a more somber one. The music of the liturgy will reflect these two themes.

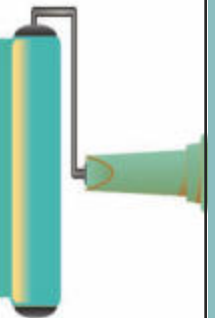
