**FROM FATHER PETER...**

**“The world’s thy ship and not thy home.”**

As I have shared with everyone before, my primary assignment from Bishop Lucia is serving as a hospital chaplain and providing for the sacramental and spiritual needs of Catholic patients who are sick and dying. One of the great privileges of this ministry is the opportunity to see the hand of God providing for His children at all the stages in life and in so many carried contexts.

The true and eternal understanding of the mystery of our human nature, suffering, life, death, and resurrection are all found in the person of Our Lord Jesus Christ. He is “the Way, the Truth, and the Life” (John 14:6). The mystery of who we are in relationship to ourselves, God, and others is one that God the Father is always working to draw us into throughout the whole of our lives—even in the *smallest things*. It is always in the *present moment* that God walks with us. Saint Padre Pio helps us to see this clearly when he says: *my past, O Lord, to Your mercy; my present, to Your love; my future, to Your providence.*

When I visit people in the hospital, I will usually give them a rosary that has been made by one of our volunteers. I have never met a person in the hospital who was not grateful to receive a rosary, even people who do not consider themselves Catholic.

People will often ask me if there is anything that they can pray for and I will usually tell them to pray a rosary. I also want to ask that when you pray, to continue to remember the sick, our homebound, and the dying—especially in the Rosary. Let us pray our rosary for those people who are unable to pray—for those whose only comfort they now have from their rosary in their hand. Let us hold them in our hands by uniting ourselves and them with Jesus and Mary in their holy rosary.

Know of my prayers for all of you and my gratitude for your prayers on behalf of all those who we do not know *that rely on us for our good works and prayers*. God bless you,
