Prayer for Bishop Lucia & the Diocese of Syracuse

God Our Father, out of the abundance of Your goodness and untold grace, You have set Your servant and priest, Bishop Douglas John Lucia, as the shepherd and High Priest of the Diocese of Syracuse.

By Your grace, Lord, make him always faithful and constant in preaching the Gospel of Christ. May he maintain the deposit of faith that comes from the Apostles and so build up the Body of Christ in the Diocese of Syracuse. May he always remain in communion of mind and heart with the successor of Saint Peter and the college of bishops in teaching, governing, and sanctifying the flock under his care; and in cooperation with the priests and deacons that share in his ministry, may he be a devoted father and sustain the people of God in guiding them along the way of salvation.
