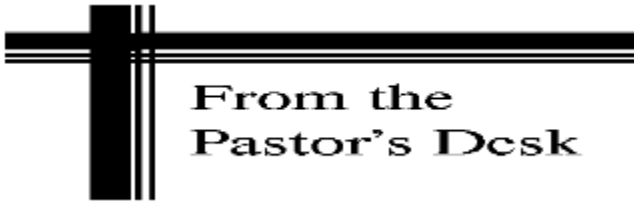

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,
Happy Labor Day weekend everyone. I hope it is enjoyable for all.

For a long time in our Church's history, work and labor were seen, based on the Book of Genesis, as a punishment by God for the sin of Adam (Genesis 3:19.) However, successive reflection upon the meaning and value of work, both for the person doing the work and for the world that benefits from it, has caused the Church to view labor not as a negative thing but rather as a way in which we participate with God in the ongoing creation of the world. Pope St. John Paul wrote an entire encyclical in 1981 entitled *On Human Labor* in which he emphasized the great dignity realized when we put our gifts and talents to use through the work to which each of us is called.

We must also remember that for most of his life, Jesus himself was a day laborer, someone who earned his living through the sweat of his brow. In his book *He Leadeth Me*, Fr. Walter Ciczek, SJ wrote the following: "There is tremendous truth contained in the realization that when God became man, he became a workingman. The Gospels show us Christ the teacher, the healer, the wonderworker, but these activities of his public life were the work of three short years. For all the rest of the time of his life on earth, God was a village carpenter and the son of a carpenter. He did not fashion benches or tables or beds by means of miracles, but by hammer and saw. He worked day in and day out for some twenty years to set us an example, to show us that these routine chores and not beneath man's dignity or even God's dignity, but noble and redemptive works worthy of God himself." So, let us celebrate the great value and dignity of work this Labor Day, and may God bless you.
