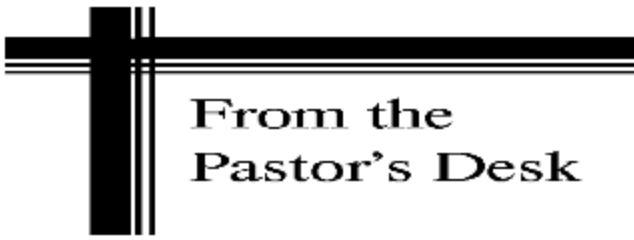

Greetings in the Lord. This week, St. Michael & St. Peter's is host to the traveling icon of St. Joseph that has been making its way around the Diocese during this "Year of St. Joseph" as a physical reminder to pray for vocations, and as a tool for vocation promotion.
