FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

Happy Halloween Weekend. Monday begins the month of November which, in the Church, is the time of year when we reflect on those aspects of our faith that have to do with the Communion of Saints, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Due to a liturgical norm, when most Holy Days of Obligation fall on either a Saturday or Monday they remain Solemnities but do not retain the obligation due to their proximity to Sunday. Such is the case with November 1st, which while still being the Feast of All Saints, is a great day to remember the Saints, yet the obligation to attend Mass is suspended. While there is the regularly scheduled 7am Mass at St. Michael-St. Peter's, no other Masses (except for my normal first Monday of the Month Mass at Ahepa Apartments) are scheduled.

November 2nd is the Feast of All Souls, a day to pray for all the deceased. The regularly scheduled 9am Mass will be celebrated at OLOH, and at 7pm a Mass will be celebrated at St. Michael's for the previous year's deceased from St. Michael-St. Peter's. The Mass offered for the previous year's deceased of Our Lady of Hope will be celebrated as part of the 4pm Mass on Saturday, November 6. All are welcomed to attend any of these celebrations.

Fr. Karl Rahner, SJ, a German theologian of the 20th Century, penned the following words and I find them a beautiful expression of our relationship with those who have gone before us. "The great and sad mistake of many people is to imagine that those whom death has taken leave us. They do not leave us. We do not see them, but they see us. Their eyes, radiant with glory, are fixed upon our eyes, full of tears. Oh the infinite consolation! They are not even absent, but living near to us, transfigured, having lost, in their glorious exchange, no delicacy of their soul, no tenderness of their hearts." May they rest in peace!
