FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK...

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

I hope this note finds you well. One of my goals as Pastor is to encourage more participation in the Liturgy. The Second Vatican Council's Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, harkening back to the celebration of the Mass in its earliest form, states that the very nature of the Liturgy itself call from every person present "full, active, and conscious participation" at Mass. This means, at its most basic form, robust and intentional spoken responses. (Sometimes the words "The Lord be with you" seem like I'm asking a trick question. Haha) This also means singing. As the music director at my previous parish stated before every Mass, "Give back to God the voice God gave you. If it's a great voice, wonderful...but if it's not a great voice, give back to God the voice he gave you." All creatures make a joyful noise to the Lord. To that end, I believe we have more sing-able music at Our Lady of Hope now, and at St. Michael-St. Peter, we could also improve our congregational singing as well. So, I encourage singing from everyone. Let's raise the roof in praise of our God!

Also, one of the ways that you might want to consider participating at Mass is to bring up the bread and wine. This is a simple gesture, but it is a symbol of all the hopes, needs, desires, struggles, and joys of every person there—represented in the bread and wine—which then are offered to God, made holy and life-giving, and given back to us as Jesus himself. To bring them up at the offertory is a simple but profound act of worship on behalf of the whole community. To bring up the gifts at St. Michael's, please see one of the ushers before Mass. To bring up the gifts at OLOH, please stop in the sacristy and see one of the sacristans. And all are invited—individuals, groups of friends, couples, families. Don't feel you have to be a traditional nuclear family to bring up the gifts. All are welcomed and encouraged to participate.
