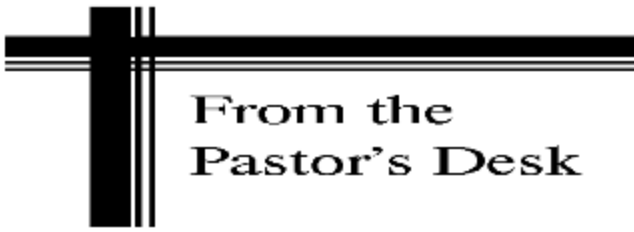

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

Throughout the month of October, you may have seen people walking around during weekend Mass with a clip board. They were our “counters” since every year the Diocese asks that we count the number of people attending each Mass during each weekend of October. I thought you might be interested in the results. Our Lady of Hope is averaging about 200 per weekend, roughly 100 per Mass; and St. Michael – St. Peter is averaging about 340 per weekend, with the 5:30pm and 11am Masses at around 100 persons each, and the 9:30 at about 140 persons attending. Given that I am new, and we are still coming ever so slowly out of Covid, I do not know how that compares to the past nor do I believe it is the “new normal.” I am hoping that Christmas, a time when many come back to church, is a good experience for all, and that by next year the attendance will be a better reflection of the actual number of households officially registered at each place. At any rate, you are our best evangelizers and advertisers, so spread the word and invite your family, your neighbors and your fellow parishioners back to Mass.

Also, I am pleased to report that we are two-thirds of the way toward our Hope Appeal goal. In years past, any monies pledged over the goal were divided between the Diocese and the parish and we received 50% back. No more! Now, any monies pledged about our goal return to the parish 100%, so don't be afraid to go over the goal. It will all stay with our respective parishes.
