

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

Today we commemorate the baptism of the Lord by John the Baptist in the Jordan River. It is the beginning of Jesus' public ministry, and according to Pope Benedict in his Book Jesus of Nazareth, this is the beginning of Jesus' stepping into the place of sinners to redeem us. It is, according to the Pope-Emeritus, a foretaste of the cross and the beginning of Christ's passion. When we hear the word "baptism," I'm sure we think immediately of the ritual or the Sacrament. However, in the Gospel of Matthew, when Jesus commands his disciples to make new disciples by baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit, he is really saying, as the word in Greek signifies, to immerse people, not just in water but in the very life of God, which is eternal life. The dynamic life of God in the Holy Trinity is not something that is reserved only for God. Rather is a community of love that we are invited into. We hear the voice from Heaven say of Jesus, "You are my beloved Son." But in truth we hear those same words addressed to us when we emerge from the Baptismal font: "You are my beloved son, my beloved daughter." Through Baptism we are invited in the communion of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It is a lot to wrap our heads around, how we, mortal and frail human beings could be raised to a member of the household of God, and yet so we are. The challenge is to live a life in response to so great a gift, reflecting outward, though word and action and the choices we make, the great dignity of being God's own beloved son; God's own beloved daughter. A NOTE REGARDING EMAIL SOLICITATIONS

There have been reports from parishioners across our diocese who have received emails and texts from individuals claiming to be their pastor. Usually the content of the message will include some form of request for money that is outside of the normal channels of giving, for example electronic gift cards for Amazon or iTunes. These messages usually include some sense of urgency and may span over several emails, beginning with an inquiry like "Hi are you available? I have a quick request." Some of these fraudulent attempts have gone so far as to create email accounts which look very much like an official address. Please be aware that neither our parish nor father will ever reach out to you directly via email, text or social media for direct solicitation of gift cards, wire transfers or other electronic monetary transactions. If you suspect you may have received a fraudulent request, or would like to confirm the genuineness of a message, please contact our parish office.
