From the

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

A quick reminder that the offices are closed tomorrow in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day. Normally when there is a National Holiday, you can expect that the office will be closed and there will not be a daily Mass offered at either parish. There are always exceptions, but that is the general rule to go by.

Last week, members of the Liturgy Committees of both Our Lady of Hope and St. Michael-St. Peter met to set a calendar for the coming year of when and where Holy Day Masses would be celebrated, how we are going, as linked parishes, to celebrate the Sacred Triduum at Eastertime. Stay tuned for an announcement of these dates. It is our goal to find ways to celebrate our liturgies as beautifully and as meaningfully as possible, given the personnel we have and the spaces that we share, to the benefit of the whole community. Of course, though we are linked parishes, we do strive to respect the autonomy and uniqueness of each parish community, but there are times when, in order to maximize the talent and energies of our music ministry and other liturgical ministries, that you will be invited to worship in a church that is not technically your own. I ask you to be open to that. So far, I have seen a marvelous openness to sharing in the celebrations of the "other" parish, whichever that might be for you, and I have appreciated this openness. Please understand that when decisions are made, they are made both out of respect for each parish community and with an eye toward what is of the greater good for the entirety of our communities.

While decisions have been made for the 2022 calendar year, we are always assessing and reassessing what works, so I invite your feedback. Thank you for your patience and openness. May God bless you all,
