

After years of dedicated service on the Pastoral Council for which all parishioners should be grateful, Council members David Nesbitt, Peter Pandori and Renée Romance are leaving the Council as their terms of office for have expired. At least two vacancies must be filled to satisfy the membership requirements of the Council Constitution.

The Pastoral Council Constitution provides that the purpose of the Pastoral Council is "to identify the spiritual and temporal needs of the parish community, and to encourage members of the parish community to participate in the life of the parish. As a Council, the members are responsible to assess the needs of our parish. The members, in consultation with the Pastor and staff, shall research and discuss and through consensus, recommend ways to meet those needs."
