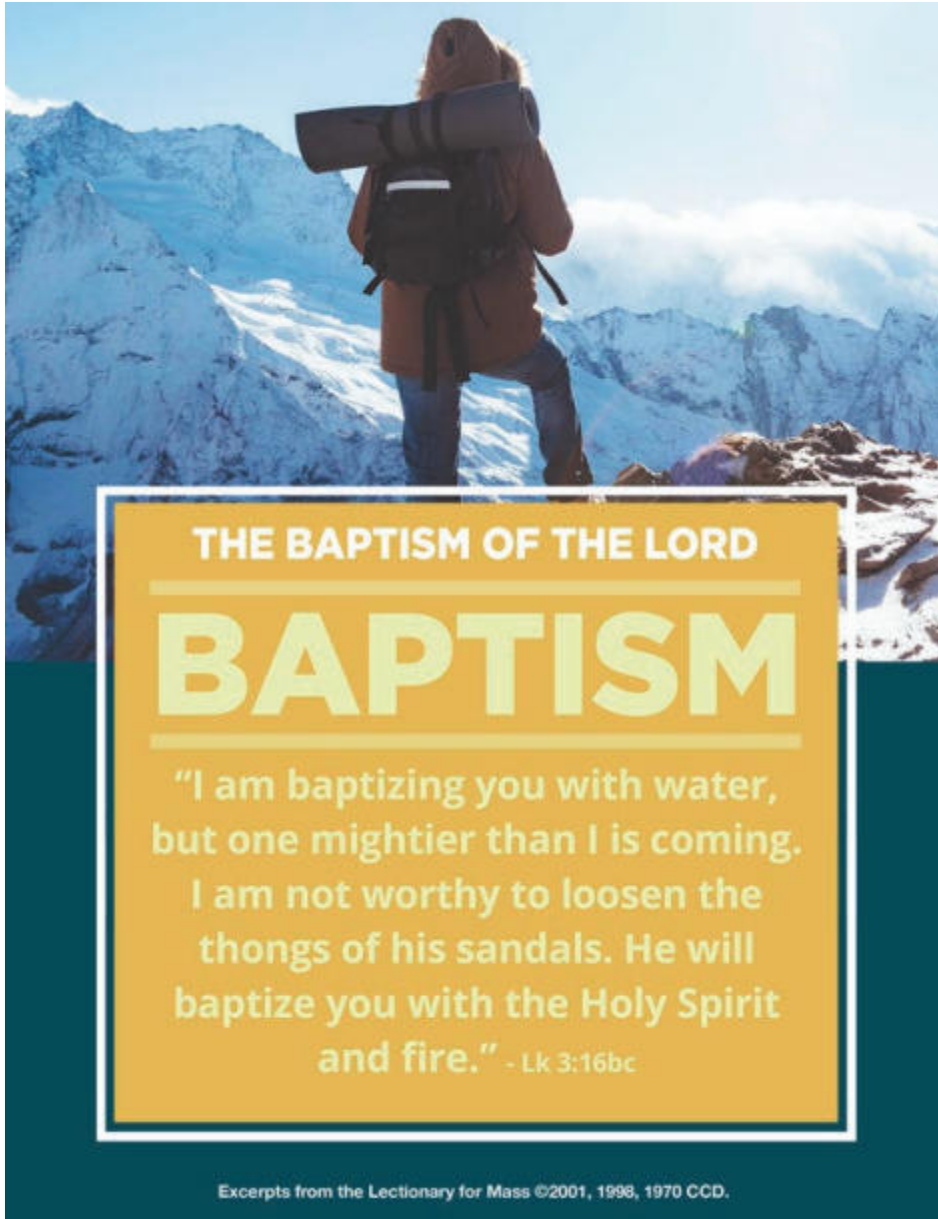



The Pastoral Council Constitution provides that the purpose of the Pastoral Council is *"to identify the spiritual and temporal needs of the parish community, and to encourage members of the parish community to participate in the life of the parish. As a Council, the members are responsible to assess the needs of our parish. The members, in consultation with the Pastor and staff, shall research and discuss and through consensus, recommend ways to meet those needs."*

The Pastoral Council recently amended its Constitution to provide that selection of new members takes place prior to its February meeting rather than waiting until its May meeting. Confirmed, registered members of the parish who are interested in serving on the Council are invited to submit a letter describing their background and why they would like to be part of the Council. Please mail the letter to: Pastoral Council, St. Mary's Church, 47 Syracuse Street, Baldwinsville, New York 13027 so that it arrives on or before January 19th, 2022.
