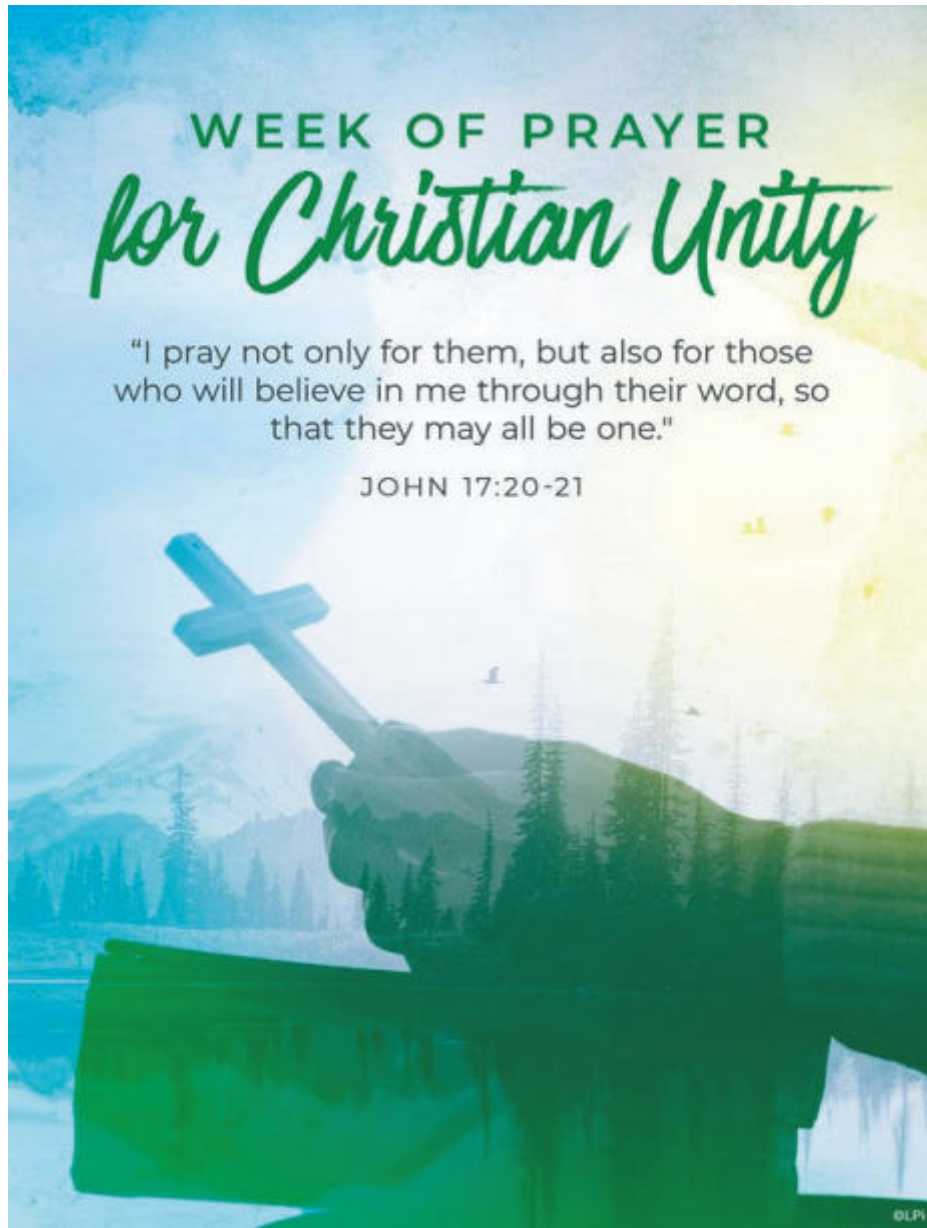

In observance of the upcoming National Day of Prayer and Penance Jan 22nd, marking the anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court's decision legalizing abortion on demand. PARISH OFFICE & MASS:

If Baldwinsville School District is delayed, there will be no morning daily Mass. If Baldwinsville School District closes, the Parish Office will be closed and there will be no daytime or evening activities (including Adoration and daily Mass). This information will be posted on our website and Facebook, as well as television stations when possible. (Weekend Masses will not be cancelled.)

FAITH FORMATION:

If the Baldwinsville School District closes or cancels after school activities, evening Faith Formation classes scheduled for that day will be cancelled. This will be posted on television stations, our website, and Facebook. Mrs. Mackey will also send out an email alert to parents.



The Pastoral Council Constitution provides that the purpose of the Pastoral Council is *"to identify the spiritual and temporal needs of the parish community, and to encourage members of the parish community to participate in the life of the parish. As a Council, the members are responsible to assess the needs of our parish. The members, in consultation with the Pastor and staff, shall research and discuss and through consensus, recommend ways to meet those needs."*

The Pastoral Council recently amended its Constitution to provide that selection of new members takes place prior to its February meeting rather than waiting until its May meeting. Confirmed, registered members of the parish who are interested in serving on the Council are invited to submit a letter describing their background and why they would like to be part of the Council.
