ART CLASS NEWS



Creativity abounds at St. Mary's Academy under the watchful eyes of Art Educator, Mrs. Michelle Ekross. To open the school year, SMA students participated in the Pinwheels for Peace Project. The Pinwheels for Peace Project is held each year in conjunction with the United Nations International Day of Peace on September 21st. Students at St. Mary's Academy designed and produced their own pinwheels, joining millions around the world in displaying colorful pinwheels, decorated with drawings, paintings, collages, photographs, with words of peace and harmony written on them on lawns, fields, and in parks.

In October students celebrated National Hispanic Month by making Vejigante masks. Students learned that the Vejigante masks represent either the devil in the battle between good and evil, or the Moors that Saint James fought during the Catholic Reconquista of Spain. To celebrate Christmas the Sixth Graders made Szopki. The Szopka is a traditional Polish folk art that has its origins in the Middle Ages. The tradition is a rich and colorful one, having evolved over the ages. The Szopki depicts the Wawel Cathedral, which is a part of Krakow's Wawel Castle with a Nativity scene set inside its doors. Some of the models are as small as 6 inches while others can reach 6 feet high. The word Szopka (crèche) is something special to the people of Poland. While the Christmas crèche is something all Christians are familiar with, it is the Polish that identify with the Szopka.

In February students celebrated Black History Month by creating art inspired by the style of Jade Purple Brown, a NYC artist known for her work using strong figures, vibrant colors, and messages of optimism.
