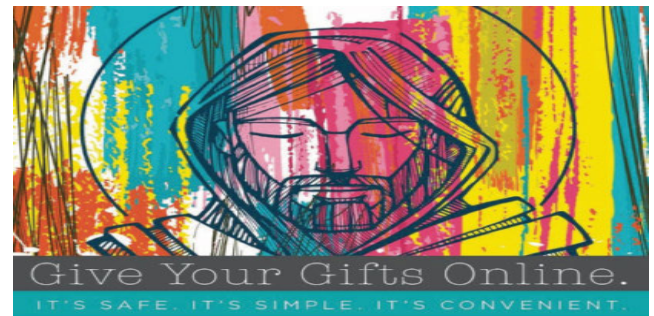

If Baldwinsville School District is **DELAYED**, there will be no morning daily Mass, and on Tuesdays, Adoration will begin at Noon.

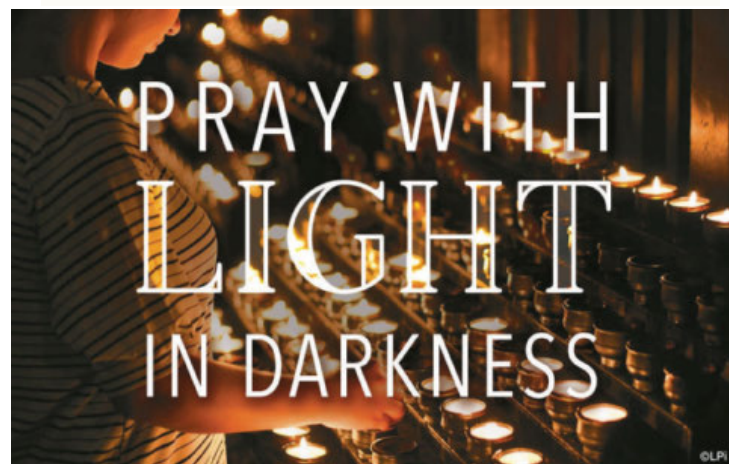

Youth Ministry Update SYRACUSE MARCH FOR LIFE

Last Saturday, some members of SASM Youth attended the annual Syracuse March for Life. We are so proud of our teens who sacrificed their Saturday morning to be a voice for the voiceless. These teens were true witnesses of Jesus Christ, and truly living out the call to being disciples. "Human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception. PRAYER VIGIL FOR AVA WOOD AND THE BALDWINVILLE SCHOOL COMMUNITY

Approximately 700 people gathered for a compelling uplifting prayer vigil held for Ava Wood who died last week in what was a tragic death. The prayer service provided the whole community, but especially the young people who knew Ava, the opportunity to grieve her passing and celebrate her life and the gift she was to all who knew her. One friend talked about how Ava counseled her when she was having a bad day. Several students shared stories of adventures the girls had together – laughing through their tears as they talked. A coach described Ava as someone “who welcomed everybody into her circle.” Ava was loving, caring, athletic, energetic, and funny.

The service was prepared and hosted by the pastoral teams of both St. Augustine’s and St. Mary’s and coordinated with the school district, the PTOs from several schools, and first responders. So many hands and hearts made it happen especially the parishioners of both parishes who really stepped up to provide refreshments and help. To all who helped “Thank you!”

Fr. Cliff commented: “It’s important for us to remember that all those people we love in this world – God will love into the next which includes Ava.” It’s important for all of us to remember that about our loved ones.

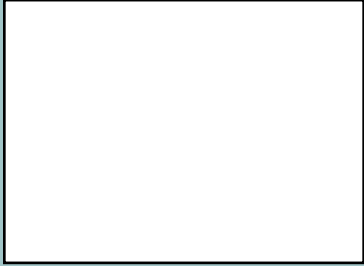
