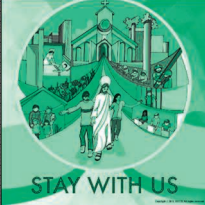

“Stay with Us” is the theme for Catechetical Ministry for the 2019-20 program year.

We as a Church work to continue a lifelong devotion to our faith in young parishioners through our Faith Formation programs. Since 1935, the third Sunday of September is set aside as Catechetical Sunday to honor and promote the

Catechesis ministry. On Catechetical Sunday, we come together as both a parish and Church community to acknowledge the dedication of those who serve as catechists in our parish family.

We also honor parents and guardians as the true first catechists, sharing the Catholic faith with their families. Catechetical Sunday is an opportunity for all Catholics to rededicate themselves to the mission of sharing our faith and being a witness to the Gospel as a community of faith. The day provides an opportunity for us to consider ways we ourselves are witnesses for Jesus Christ.

We as a faith community have the responsibility of supporting our young members and encouraging their growth in our faith. We are called to use our talents through volunteering and prayers.

What does Catechetical Mean?

Most of us are familiar with the word Catechism and are aware of its traditional role in the Church’s teaching. The root word of Catechesis is from the Greek word meaning “echo”, or “resound”. According to the National Conference of Catholic Bishops, “Catechesis is the act of resounding or bringing the Church’s teachings to the world. A Catechist is someone who teaches in the name of the Church.”
