## Pastor's Desk

### *Formation for Ministry/Deacon Formation Information Session*

The next Formation for Ministry/Deacon Formation Information Session is scheduled for Sunday, April 3, at 1pm at St. Vincent DePaul Blessed Sacrament Church in Vestal. If you or someone you know is interested in learning more about lay ministry and/or the process of becoming a deacon, please plan to attend! Register at [formationforministrysy.org](http://formationforministrysy.org). The Formation for Ministry program provides education, ministerial training, field experience, and spiritual preparation for adult Catholics leading to certification and commissioning by the diocesan bishop in a specialized area of ministry. The program prepares candidates to assist pastors to serve the needs of a parish or pastoral care area and is the first two years of deacon formation.

### *What is a Deacon and his role?*

Deacons are members of the clergy along with priests and bishops. The deacon's ministry has three dimensions: liturgy, word and service. At the liturgy, he assists the bishop and priests. Catholics recognize two types of deacons:

- Permanent deacons are men ordained to an office in the Catholic Church who normally have no intention or desire of becoming priests. He can be single or married. If the latter, he must be married before being ordained a deacon. If his wife dies before him, he may be ordained a priest if the bishop permits and approves. Permanent deacons, especially those who are married, have secular jobs to support their families and also help the local pastor by visiting the sick, teaching the faith, counseling couples and individuals, working on parish committees and councils, and giving advice to the pastor.

- Transitional deacons are seminarians, students in the last phase of training for the Catholic priesthood. After being a deacon for a year, they're ordained a priest by the bishop.

At the Mass, the deacon proclaims the Gospel, may be invited to preach the homily, and assists at the altar. Deacons can baptize, witness marriages, perform funeral and burial services outside of Mass, distribute Holy Communion, preach the homily (which is the sermon given after the Gospel at Mass), and are obligated to pray the Divine Office (Liturgy of the Hours/Breviary) each day.

Most Deacons do not work full-time in the Church as Deacon Dale did before his retirement in 2020. Also, Deacons do have a vast array of responsibilities, determined by their assignment and skills. Some Deacons are assigned to hospitals and Nursing Homes. some to parishes and some in schools and outreach ministries. They do retire from their work, and some retire from their ministry, it is up to the individual and local church policies.

### WHY DO WE DO THAT?

#### Catholic Life Explained

*Why are Catholic and Protestant Bibles different?*

Since the earliest days of the Church, Christians used a Greek translation of the Old Testament known as the Septuagint. This collection of the texts of the Hebrew Scriptures included 46 books. At the time of the Protestant Reformation in the 1500s, the Protestant reformers began to create their own translations of the Bible (into local languages) and some began to question why the Jewish Scriptures would have included texts that were written in Greek, because, they assumed, the only valid Jewish Scriptures would have been written in Hebrew. And so, they decided to remove seven books from the Old Testament: Baruch, Sirach, 1 and 2 Maccabees, Tobit, Judith and Wisdom (as well as portions of the Books of Daniel and Esther). This means that the Protestant Old Testament only includes 39 books, while Catholic Bibles continue to include those original 46 books. Both Catholic and Protestant Bibles include 27 books and letters in the New Testament.

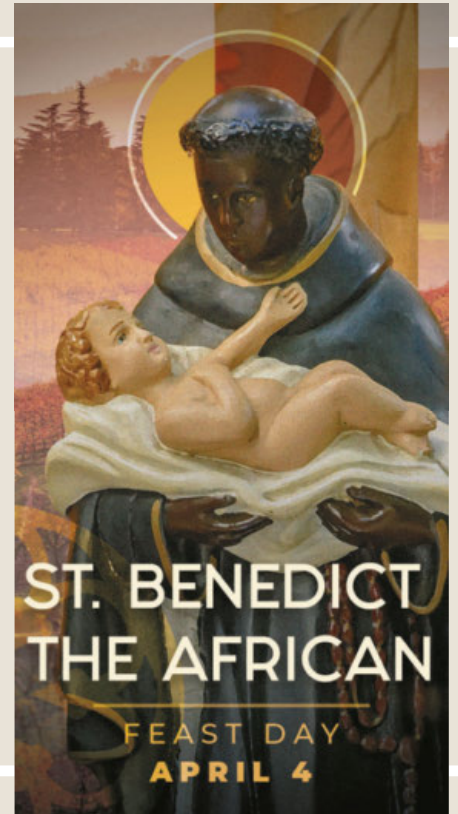
#### Scholarship Opportunities

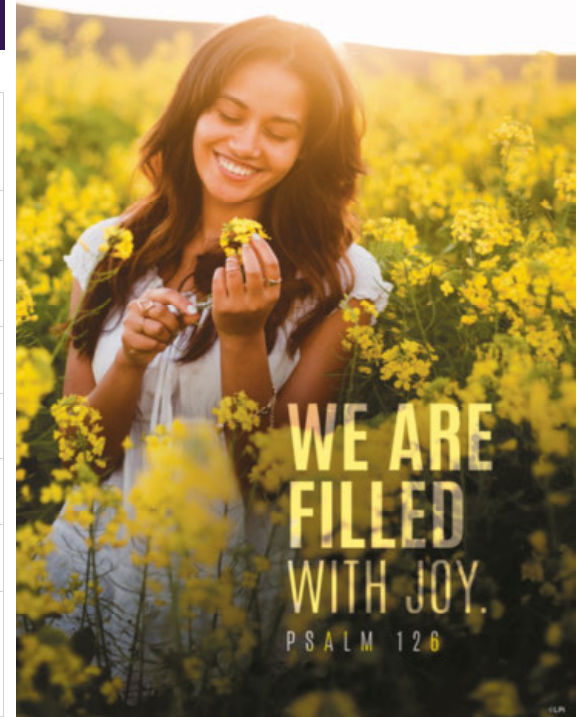
St. Benedict the African (1524-1589), was born in San Fratello, Sicily to Cristoforo and Diana Manasseri, Africans who had been taken as slaves. Some accounts claim that because of his parents' loyal service that Benedict was given his freedom at birth, other sources say that his freedom was granted when he turned 18. At 21 Benedict joined a society of hermits living under the rule of St. Francis of Assisi. Eventually he succeeded his friend, Jerome Lanze, as their leader. When the Pope disbanded the independent hermit society, Benedict joined the Order of Friars Minor and he was sent to Palermo, to the Franciscan Friary of St. Mary of Jesus. There Benedict worked in the kitchens and despite being illiterate and a lay brother (not a priest), he also served as Master of Novices, and as Guardian of the Community. St. Benedict was known throughout his life as a brilliant cook under whose hands food seemed to multiply miraculously, a healer, and a spiritual leader with profound understanding. He is recognized as the patron saint of African Americans.

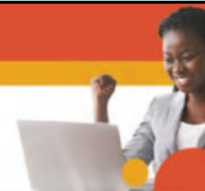


