

Faith Formation

- What's your favorite restful activity that truly nourishes and rejuvenates you?

Challenge

- Truly practice the sabbath this week. Plan ahead. And plan a ritual to mark it off from the rest of the week.
- Savor moments. Stop and smell the roses (Literally) in some small way each day.
- Don't rest lazily. Think of something you need to do to dive deep into quality "re-creation."

Prayer

 Prayerfully reflect on Exodus 20:8 ...Remember the Sabbath Day, to keep it holy... God commanded us to rest. It's essential for our happiness. How can you rest in a very busy world?



Take it to Prayer: Reflect on whether you've been experiencing true rest each week. Practice resting in the Lord.

Look with favor on our earthly fathers. They helped create us in your image. We have disappointed them, but have come to realize just how important they are to us.

Mary will lead young people to Jesus for a lifetime. Totus Tuus promotes Marian devotion, especially by promoting and teaching the Rosary to children and youth.






