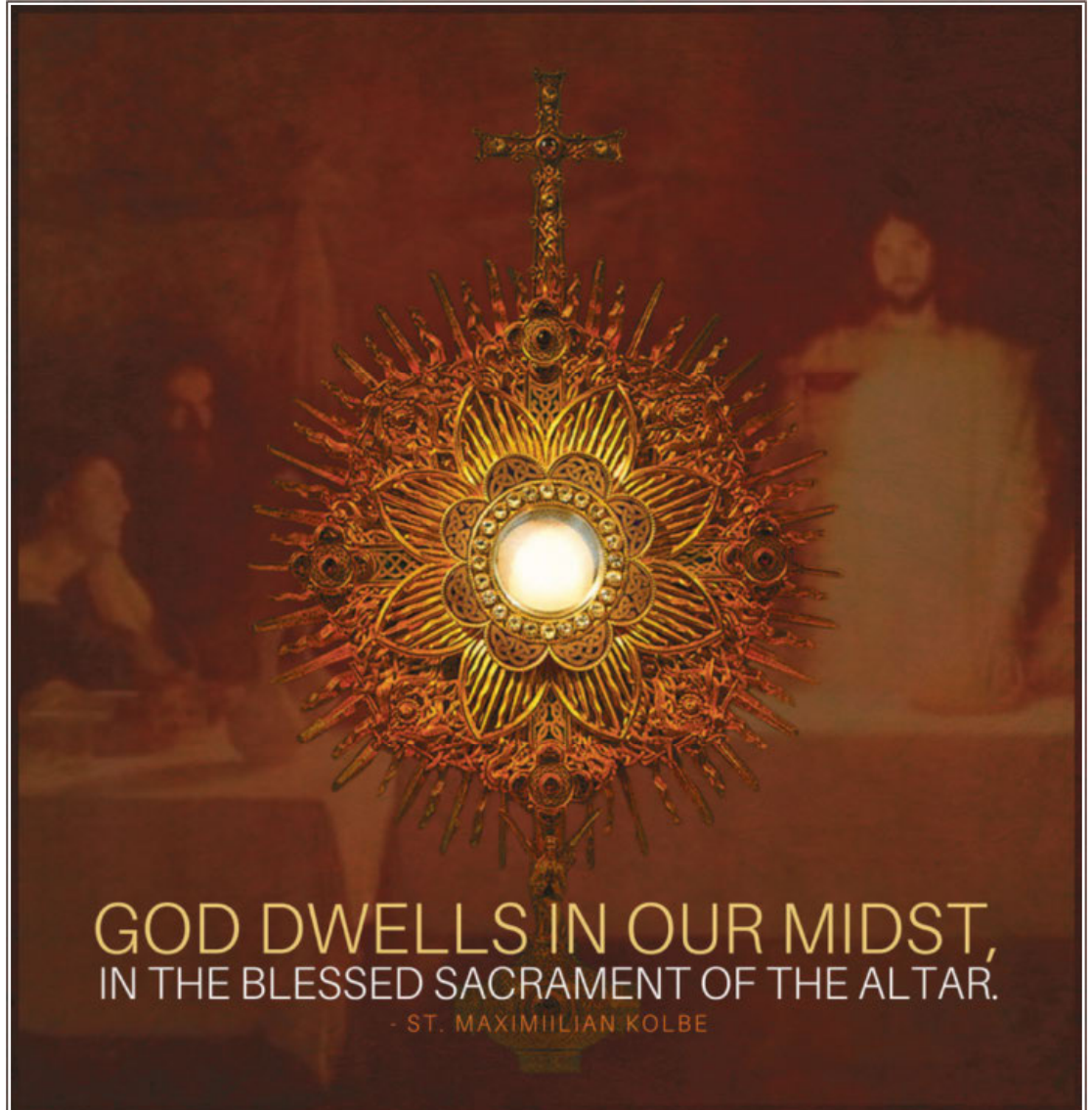

Journal Questions

- Can you relate with the Lamplighter in *The Little Prince*? When did your life speed up?
- Look over your weekly routine. Is there a good balance between work and rest? What tends to throw off that balance the most?
- What stops your from deeply resting even when you're not working?
- What's your favorite restful activity that truly nourishes and rejuvenates you?
- How do you honor the Sabbath? What can you do to honor it better?

Challenge

- Truly practice the sabbath this week. Plan ahead. And plan a ritual to mark it off from the rest of the week.
- Savor moments. Stop and smell the roses (Literally) in some small way each day.
- Don't rest lazily. Think of something you need to do to dive deep into quality "re-creation."

Prayer

- Prayerfully reflect on Exodus 20:8 ...*Remember the Sabbath Day, to keep it holy...* God commanded us to rest. It's essential for our happiness. How can you rest in a very busy world?

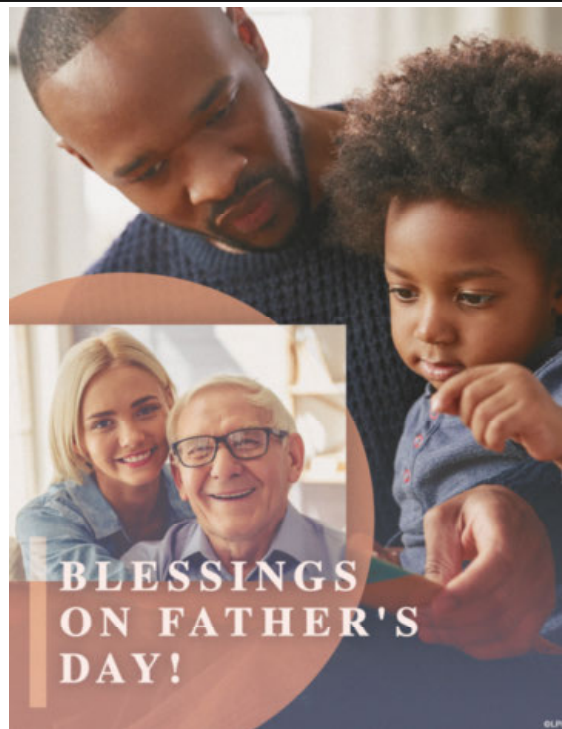

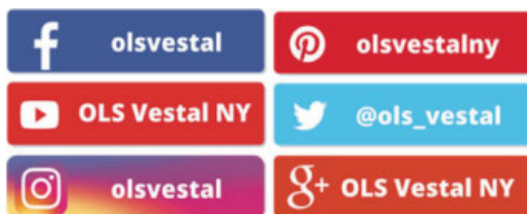

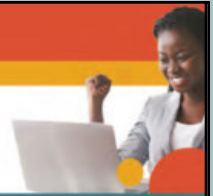
