### MULL-ING THINGS OVER

Most of us know the Church has dedicated the month of May to Mary, our Blessed Mother. Part of the reason for this is that May is a month of Spring. We have Spring flowers in full bloom, trees have their leaves developing, grass is growing, and the earth has come alive after the Winter sleep. It is a month of nurturing and gives us a sense of mothering. It is no wonder that Mother's Day has also been placed in May. Today is Mother's Day and we honor all our mothers with prayers, parties, gifts, cards, and signs of love. Mother's Day in the United States is also a day that we honor Mary. In passed years, we have had a flower sale on Mother's Day and by the last Mass of the day, the statues of Mary in our churches would be surrounded by flowers. They are symbols of the love and devotion we offer to Mary – Jesus' Mother and our own!

My Mom used to shy away from Mother's Day. She used to tell us that we had better places to spend our money and she really didn't need anything. She would ask us to pray for her and when we were little to be good – that was what she wanted the most. We, her children, loved her and respected her, but did not pay attention to her in this particular instance. We would have picnics or parties and buy her little gifts and she seemed to really treasure every one of them. I remember some of our Mother's Days after dinner, everyone was cleaning up the kitchen and my mom would sit there beaming as she watched us all working. I am not sure if she was happy because she did not have to do the clean up or because she was enjoying seeing her children all involved in a common project – laughing, talking, telling stories and enjoying our large families. I never asked her, but I am pretty sure after we all left, she then put her kitchen back to the way she wanted it.

What I do know was that my Mom was never happier than when all nine of us would go to Church with her. She would troop us all down the main aisle. We would often fall into place by age as we proceeded into the pew. There were a few of us she did not want to sit next to one another. And when she took her seat, we all plunked down. The whole church probably knew the Mulls had arrived. When we stood around her outside, you could sense her pride and the love she had for all of us.

She was, of course, the hit at my ordination. A reporter asked her if she wasn't proud to have a son a priest. I still remember her answer – "I am proud of all my children. Yes, I am proud of Tom, but I am proud of what each and every one of my children has accomplished." I could not have answered that question any better and that was exactly the way she treated us. She never encouraged competition between us. She taught us that we were all different and could only become what God wanted us to be. "Develop your own talents," she said, "I don't want you to be anyone but yourself – that is the person I gave birth to."

My Mom was always a little nervous when we were all out in public at the same time and in the same place. She used to say, "What one doesn't think of the other does!" So, I used to think how exhausted she probably was when an event came to an end. Her worst fears were never realized – we had behaved. I used to joke with her – at least you know, Mom, that we all had a good time – and you and Dad did as well. Whether it was a wedding reception, or graduation, or one of the many Baptisms and First Communions we celebrated together, we enjoyed each and every celebration. Our sacramental celebrations were of utmost importance. My Dad and Mom were happy to see the newest grandchild/great grandchild baptized! They smiled proudly at First Communions and Confirmations. I was usually a part of such celebrations and they were glad I was there and doing what I was supposed to be doing and doing it well and happily. Whenever Mother's Day rolls around for some reason I think of all the sacraments we, Mulls, have received and I thank God that my Mom was the one who guided us through to these celebrations.

We wish all our mothers a happy and blessed Mother's Day. Thank you for accepting the call of God to be a mother! Thank you for bringing the gift of life into the world through your children. Thank you for bringing them to the Lord repeatedly through prayer and our sacraments. Thank you for adopting Mary as the model for your motherhood. Mary did not have an easy life. She lived with many questions, she had to draw on her faith to deal with all the unanswered questions of her life, she had the horrible experience of watching her own Son die before her eyes – and then, she had to bury him. She never denied her motherhood. She always took pride in her vocation and in so doing, she found God. May this month of May, this month of life, this month of Mary be for all of us, a month of life, rejuvenation, and hope!
